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#### Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2021/22

Apac Municipal had a total budget of UShs 20,012,304,000 for the FY 2021/2022. By the end of O3, the cumulative receipts were UShs 18,194,589 000 which is 91% of the Budget Received above the expected 75% due to more releases from development grants and Supplementary Budgets for COVID 19. The bulk of the receipt being Other Government Transfers UShs 11.114.742..000 representing 2898% of the Budget Received, Conditional Government transfers of UShs 5,877,862,000 translating into 83% of the budget Received, Discretionary Government transfers UShs 1,022,220,000 representing 8% of the Budget Received and Locally raised revenues amounted to UShs 179,765,000 representing 69% of the Budget Received. The overall performance was 61% out of the expected 50%. This performance is above expected 50% attributed to the fact that development grant is released at 66%. These receipts were disbursed to all departments for various activities to be implemented as planned. The cumulative expenditure at the end of the quarter was UShs 9,735,139, 000 translating into 49% of the budget spent. Out of this, UShs 2,759,903,000 was spent on wage representing 67% of the budget spent, UShs 1,427,554,000 was spent on non-wage recurrent activities representing 54% of the budget spent and UShs 5,547,682,000 was spent on domestic development activities which is 42% of the budget spent. Poor performance was registered in the department of Production and Marketing (20%) due to money for PDM who is unused awaiting for guidance, Natural resources due to money for purchases of gadgets and tools under USMID project still in progress, Education, Roads and engineering each at (46%) due development projects which are still ongoing and Trade& Industry (52%) due to accumulated rental for one stop center to be paid in O4. The cumulative Unspent balance amounted to UShs 8,459,450,000 comprising of UShs 414,218,000 wage, UShs 395,099,000 Non wage and UShs 7,650,133,000 from domestic Development. The overall reason for unspent balance in the account are: Wage of UShs 414,218,000 is to cater for payment of deductions to URA, payment of teachers and health workers under advertisement. Non wage of UShs 395,099,000 is for pension and gratuity, and activities under various departments whose release was small and waiting for its accumulation in Q4 and domestic development of UShs 7,650,133,000 is due activities still under procurement process in education department and USMID work which is now ongoing under roads and engineering department

#### **Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues**

Apac Municipal had Approved Local Revenues of UShs 261,000,000 for the FY 2021/2022. By the end of quarter three, the Municipality had received a cumulative total of UShs 179,765,000 which is 69% of the budget received less than the expected collection of 75%. The deviation from the planned figure resulted from low performance registered from sources like; Ground rent (5%), Local Hotel Tax (33%), Business Licenses (44%), Application fees(55%) and Registration of (Births, Deaths, Marriages etc) (49%).

#### **Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers**

Apac Municipal had approved a total of UShs12,249,101,000 as Discretionary Government Transfers, Conditional Government Transfers UShs 7,118,703,000 for the FY 2021/2022. By the end of Q3, the cumulative receipts were UShs 1,022,220,000 from Discretionary Government Transfers which is 8% of the Budget Received and UShs 5,877,862,000 from Conditional Government Transfers translating into 83%. Deviation from Discretionary Government Transfers was due to Upload of USMID fund as Other Government transfers and Deviation from Conditional Government Transfers was due to more release from Sector Conditional Grant Wage (76%), Sector Development Grant (99%) and Transitional Development Grant (100%) and pension for LGs (78%).

#### **Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers**

Apac Municipal had Approved UShs 383,500,000 as Other Government Transfers for the FY 2021/2022. By the end of quarter three, the Municipality had received a total of UShs 11,114,742,000 which is 2898 % of the Budget Received. This performance is far much above the expected level of 75%. due to upload of USMID fund as other transfers from Central government

#### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department of administration received a total revenue of Ugx. 1,267,264,000 translating to 85% of the budget spent above expected 75% due to more releases from development grant for the second quarter. These revenues comprise of Ugx.264,135,000 which is 84% of the budget spent, from Urban unconditional grant wage, Ugx. 16,314,000 from Urban Unconditional grants non wage which is 78% of the budget spent, Ugx. 80,048,000 from pension for local government which is 78% of the budget spent, Ugx.36,924,000 which is 76% of the budget spent was from Multisectoral transfers to LLGs, Non-Wage, Ugx.22,288,000 which is 73% of the budget spent was from Locally raised revenues and gratuity of Ugx. 238,091,000 which is 75% of the budget spent and 609,463,000 which is 94% of the budget spent was from domestict development. The department then spent a cumulative total of Ugx 1,006,318 translating into 68% of the budget spent comprising of Ugx. 250,342,000 was spent on Wage representing 79% of the budget spent, Ugx. 216,502,000(42%) was spent on nonwage and domestic development of Ugx. 539,474 representing 83% of the budget spent. This leaves unspent balance of Ugx 260,945,000 representing 21% of the budget spent comprising of Wage Ugx 13,793,000, Nonwage Ugx 177,163,000 and domestic development Ugx 69,989,000.

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The reason for unspent fund from Wage of Ugx 13,793,,000 is for payment of deductions for URA and UCLA, Domestic Development of Ugx 69,989,000 is as a result of the delay in the getting of contractor for the division office block. Non wage of Ugx 177,163,000 is for payment of Gratuity and Pension. Some funds meant for capacity building for staff could not be spent since training. There was also delay in delivering some office equipment and furniture.

#### Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

The department of administration used the fund released in the quarter to pay for staff salaries, administration block, office equipment, Capacity building, payment of subscriptions, partial procurement of motor vehicle, Purchase of land at the divisions, purchase of office furniture and ICT equipment.

Out of Which 10,267,000/= is Locally Raised Revenue Recurrent representing 200%, 30,163,000/= Multi-sectoral Transfer to Lower Local Government representing 119%, 22,500,000/= unconditional Grant Non- Wage representing 75%, wage 105,263,000/=Representing 75% and Domestic Development of 25,118,000= representing 56% of the budget spent. The department then spent a total of 163,688,000/= representing 64% of the budget spent comprising of Wage 84,816,000/=(60%), non wage 53,753,000/=(75%) and domestic development 25,118,000= (56%). This leaves the total recurrent unspent balance of 29,622,000/= represent 18% of which Wage is 20,446,000/=, non-Wage 9,176,000/= and Development 7,776, 000/=-which is 24% of the budget spent. The cumulative unspent balance at the end of Q3 was 37,398,000= which is 19% of the budget spent.

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#### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By the end of quarter three, the department of statutory bodies received a cumulative total revenue of 193,872,000= which is 71% of the budget spent below expected 75% due to low release from Locally raised revenues at 45% and domestic development of 61%. This revenue comprises of Local revenue 14,405,000=which is 45%, multi- sectoral transfers to LLG 20,969,000= which is 75% of the budget spent, unconditional grant non wage 124,934,000= which is 75%, unconditional grant wage 31,122 ,000= which is 75% and domestic development of 2,443,000= which is 61% of the budget spent. The quarter three revenue outturn amounted to 59,774,000= which is 88% of the Quarters Plan. The department then used a cumulative total of 188,690,000= which is 69% of the budget spent. Of this 30,790,000=(74%) was spent on wage and 155,457,,000= (68%) was spent on non wage and 2,443,000= (61%) was spent on domestic development. However the quarters total expenditures was 61,609,000= which is 90% of the quarter plan. This expenditure exceeds revenues due to the payment of arrears of council allowances not cleared in Q1 and domestic development on motorcycle of Arocha which was not paid in Q1. This leaves unspent balance of 5,813,000= which is 3% of the budget spent. This unspent comprises of wage 332,000= ,non wage 4,851,000= and domestic development of 0 which is 0% of the budget spent.

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balance in the account of Wage category of 332,000=, will be used to clear for deductions to URA, non wage of 4851,000= is for payment of LCI and LCII chairpersons ex gratia at the end of the financial year.

The revenues released comprises of sector conditional grant non-wage UGX 193,727000 which translates to 53% of the budget spent, sector conditional grant wage of UGXs 40,500,000 which translates to 75% of the budget spent, sector development grant UGXs 40,790,000 which translates to 78% of the budget spent and the Locally raised revenue UGX 1,631,000 which translates to 75%.
