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#### Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2021/22

Revenue: By the end of 3rd quarter, amount received was ushs 32.92bn representing 79% of the projected annual income including shs 15,122,691,000 received from the USMID programme but not captured wholly by the MoFPED loaded releases for the 3 quarters. We have thus partly captured it (shs 14,745,881,000) under 'Other Government Transfers' rather than under 'Discretionary Government Transfers' where it had been budgeted in Engineering. The high over performance of revenue was due to the release of a third of the development grants but budget had expected a quarter. All receipts by the city were disbursed to departments and Lower Local Governments in the quarter. A sizable part of USMID funds however, were not utilised because their meant projects were still under implementation and certificates yet to be presented for payment. The cumulative release for wage was 76%. The out turn for the non-wage recurrent was 56% due to low LRR of sh. 1.348bn and late acquisition of cash limits, lower URF (40%) and no PLE funds. UWEP also released and a supplementary budget granted for 6m. Other conditional Grant non-wage recurrent were all released as planned. Discretionary development grants fell short of the capture of USMID grants leading to only 2% realization instead of 100% actually got. Regarding expenditure, by the end of quarter 3, stood at 51% cumulatively including expenditure under multi sectoral transfers to Lower Local Governments. When decomposed by revenue category, total expenditure as a percentage of the budget during the FY under review stood as follows: wage: 61%, non-wage recurrent: 42% and domestic development: 48%. The low funds absorption for domestic development was mainly because implementation of most ongoing development projects (esp. USMID) is midway while for others, contracting had also just been concluded.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues**

Significant deviation was due to the season being non-peak to taxpayer. The total LRR collection was 1.348bn for the 3 quarters but remitted to the centre and warranted amounted shs 947.8m compared to the budget of 4.6bn. Performance was thus 29% of budget. Major cause for poor collections was the COVID-19 pandemic and unrealized revenue from sale of the property (worth over 1 billion) as had been included in the budget.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers**

The deviation is mainly because money received from USMID pgm was not captured by MoFPED in the Q1, Q2 & Q3 releases. Only 376.8m for division DDEG was captured on that line rather than that total shs 15,122.691m that would have appeared on that line alone. All other grants performed as expected.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers**

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Deviation was due to release of only 40% of the expected half year amount for Uganda Road Fund while the other source budgeted (PLE) also never realized a single coin. Note that even the unloaded funds by MoFPED was later considered under this category and thus blew up the performance to 1440%.

#### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The Department received a total of UGX 1.1 billions of which shs 342.5m was wage, shs 15.4m was from LRR recurrent, 13.5m was from UUCG-NW, shs 198.9m Pension for LG, shs 24.4m Gratuity for LG, shs 155.6m for LLG development under Multisectoral transfers GOU and Shs 100M from OGTs. Expenditures totaled to shs 288.5M of which 89.5m was wage and the rest financed other recurrent costs including pensions, gratuity and arrears, utilities, computer accessories, stationery and inland travels. Shs 57.7m was spent on development as the transfers under USMID / DDEG to LLGs.

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Wage: The balance of shs 796m was partly unprocessed PAYE and partly due to the delay in approving the city staff structure and subsequent recruitment to fill gaps. For non-wage, the balance of shs 547.2m included gratuity, pension and Arrears that remain unpaid due to lacking documents among the beneficiaries. Development: 381.1M was not yet utilised, however, the procurement process was finalised and utilisation of these funds likely to take place in 4th Quarter.

#### Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Staff salaries paid, utilities paid, gratuity paid, court cases handled, trainings organized and attended, staff issues handled. Procurement services/ activities handled as per the schedule.

#### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The Department received a total of UGX 110.3m of which shs 76.5m was wage, shs 18.8m was from LRR, shs 15.023m was from UUCG-NW including the 7.5m for IFMS maintenance. There was no Sector Conditional Grant recurrent nonwage as expected. Expenditures totaled to shs 50.4m (about 45.7% of the released) of which 26.5m was wage. The rest (23.9m) financed other recurrent costs including utilities, computer accessories, stationery and inland travels.

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#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Wage: The balance of shs 150.4m was un processed PAYE and also deduction from 2 staff on interdiction receiving half salary. Staff structure is also not yet approved by Parliament of Uganda and thus hopes of recruitment of more staff still frustrated. Non Wage: The balance of shs 23.9m is for activities to be actually implemented in 4th quarter.

Warrants for 3rd quarter made, all required transfers made to schools and health units. Staff salaries were paid to all the staff, home to office transport refund paid to all the Finance Staff, Office Computers maintained, liaison with the line ministries facilitated and done, IFMS strong room and generator maintained, half year accounts produced for FY 2021/22.
