By the end of quarter four the Amudat district had realized Shs 17,798,236,000 against an annual budget of Shs 14,047,682,000 being 127% budget performance. Of which from the central government source the district realized Shs 16,407,565,000 against an annual budget of Shs 10,206,991,000 for the year. Most central government funds performed as planned for the quarter at 100% and above for both non wage recurrent and development grants, however there were some variances in the performance during the quarters because some grants performed beyond 100% due to additional funds the district received from Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic development especially for education, health, water, pension and start up funds for the new administrative units under the district unconditional grant non wage. From the other central government source the district realized Shs 214,923,000 against an annual budget of Shs 999,530,000 being 22% budget performance for the year. Nearly all the other central government funds didn't performed as planned for the quarter at 100% ie Youth Livelihood Programme. Northern Uganda Social Action Fund (NUSAF), Support to PLE, Uganda Women Entrepreneurship Program (UWEP), Youth Livelihood Programme (YLP), Results Based financing (RBF). The Ministries are yet to communicate to the District why funds were not released. From the local revenue source the district had realized Shs 43,316,000 against an annual budget of Shs 46,873,000 being 92% budget performance. Whereas the performance at 92%, several local revenue sources performed poorly. Poor local revenue collection was witness during the quarter because markets which contribute a big portion of the district local revenue had just been opened due to Covid 19 pandemic. From the external financing the district 1,132,642,000 against an annual budget of Shs 2,794,288,000 being 41% budget performance. Nearly all the sources for external financing performed poorly apart from World Health Organization (WHO) that performed at 347% and Global Alliance for Vaccines and Immunization (GAVI) that had performed at 79%. The District is to write to those that performed poorly reminding them of their commitment. By the end of guarter four all the funds received had been disbursed to the departments. All departments performed well with the exception of Administration due to the newly funded administrative units.

Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

Administration department received a total revenue of 1,540,309,000/= and the total expenditure of the quarter was 885,821,000/= of which wage was 66,481,000/= and Non wage 247,025,000/=. The overall underperformance arose from the non implementation of constructions as a delay on the procurement processes. Whereas there was a general under performance in the revenues, the department registered remarkable over performance under the recurrent revenues in particular pension and salary arrears for which funds were released 100% and also local revenue The total expenditure of the department for the quarter stood at only 103% of the quarter's planned expenditure and this was mainly contributed by the development expenditure component which arose from delays to the procurement processes as the district was still conducting the procurement process. This has however been sorted and all the projects were paid as per work done.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Due to incomplete work by the contractors.
