### Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2017/18


By the end of the first half of the FY, the District a received a cumulative total of 14,753,706,000/= representing 49% of the district annual budget. Of the funds received 77% was conditional transfers, 12% was discretionary transfers, 5% was other transfers, 3% was donor funds and 2% was locally raised revenue. revenue performance was generally good with the exception of education grant of UPE and USE which performed below 50.. All other government transfer were released at 50% and above i.e. UNEB released 21,000,000/= above the IPF of 14,000,000/=. All the central government transfers were released at 50% and above to enable the LG to pay for on going projects.

Under the conditional transfers most of the grants aslo performed at 50% and above to enable the LG to pay for the on going projects under SFG, Works and production departments and aslo to [pay all arrears of salary, pension and gratuity. For donor funds, by the end of the first half of the FY, the district received 43% of its annual budget. Revenue performance under this source was below average because the district realized little funds from UNICF as most of the planned activities were rolled to third quarter.

For the two quarter, the district spent a cumulative total of 13,809,172,000/= which was 94% of the total release. Of the total expenditure 9,194,557,000/= (67%) was spent on payment of salaries fro primary & secondary teachers, tertiary instructors, Political leader, health workers and tradition staff at the District and LLGs. 3,415,039,000/= (25%) was spent on non wage recurrent activities like fuel and allowance for monitoring and supervision, Road maintenance and rehabilitation and other administrative expenses. 979,009,000/= (7%) was spent on development projects like construction of the foundation of the southern wing of the district administration block, payment of retention for the construction of the district council hall. and 220,567,000/= (2%) was spent on donor activities i.e. payment of contract staff salaries under MUWRP and Birth registration under NIRA.

The District had un spent balance of 944,926,000/= which was 6% of the released funds. Of the total balance, the biggest percentage of the un spent was in the education department and this was so because of the un paid salaries to the newly coded school of Nalinya Iren Ndagire SS who were not yet fully appointed and the rest of the un spent in the same sector was due to the un paid contractors who had submitted their requisitions late. 20% was under health department was payment of contract staff under donor funding whose contracts had expired. 16% was under administration department which was balance under pension, gratuity and salary arrears . 9% was under production department for agricultural extension services because the funds were not in the budget thus awaiting for approval of the the supplementary budget. 5% was for the on going works of road maintenance and renovation of the natural resource office which had been completed but the contractor has not requested for. and other balance were funds for operation expenses as the district waits for quarter three release in the departments of Community, water and finance

### **Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues**

In terms of local revenue, the district collected a cumulative total of 356,557,000/= representing 25% of its annual budget. Revenue collection were below average because the district did not realize funds under some sources like other court fees, Agency fees, group registration, property related duties and most of the other sources performed below the average like Park fees, other fees and charges, land fees, and other licensed due to political pronouncements in regard to tax park fees. Despite the general poor performance of most locally raised revenue sources, the district realizes 102% under local service tax because we recruited new staff like teachers, extension agricultural workers and records officer in HC III which increased the receipts under Local Service Tax.

#### **Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers**

By the end of the first half of the FY, the district received a cumulative total of 13,987,791,000/= representing 50% of the district annual budget, this constituted of Discretionary, conditional and other government transfers.

By the end of quarter two with the exception of education grants for UPE & USE which performed below 50%, all other grants were released at 50% and above for example, UNEB released 21millions above the IPF of 14millions. All central Gov't transfers under discretionary grants were released at 50% and above to enable the LG pay for ongoing projects especially under DDDEG. Under the conditional transfers, most of the grants also performed at 50% and above to enable the LG pay for ongoing projects under SFG, works and production department and also pay for all arrears of salaries, pension and gratuity. However in line with the president's directive and guidance by the MoES on education releases, no non wage release was made under UPE, USE and Inspection grants in quarter two

### **Cumulative Performance for Donor Funding**

For donor funds, by the end of the first half of the FY, the district received 409,357,000/= representing 43% percentage release of the annual budget. Revenue performance was below the average because the district realized little funds from UNICEF as most of the planned activities were rolled to third quarter as data entry was not completed on time due to the problems associated with data base and internet.

### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By the end of the first half of the financial year, the department received a cumulative total of 1,654,314,000/= representing 48% of the department annual budget. Of the funds received 20% was un conditional grant wage for the district and urban, 19% was pension arrears, 19% was pension for local government, 15% was salary arrears, 11% was gratuity, 8% was development while 8% was non wage recurrent. The Department received more Unconditional Grant(111%) because we had allocated all the Locally raised Revenues yet the Department had emergencies to handle. similarly, more Unconditional Grant-Wage was allocated following the activation of two parish chiefs on the payroll. Local Revenue was below 50% because the overall collection was also below 50%. Pension was above 50% because of additional Cash limit of 22 millions in Quarter 2. Salary arrears and Pension Arrears performed at 100% because the plan was to pay all arrears in Quarter i and 2.

Cumulatively, the department spent a total of 1,501,068,000/= representing 44% of the department annual budget. The Department spent 53% on payment of staff salaries on its annual wage budget because some staff who were accessed on pay roll around December 2017. Non wage was at 43% because some domestic arrears (salary arrears) lacked supporting documents thus were not paid by end of December 2017. Development expenditure at 32% on its development annual budget because we did not receive development funds from Mo-LG as planned

In the quarter under review, the department received a total of 877,018,000/= which was 102% of the quarterly budget. The revenue performance was more than 100% because the district had received once its annual budget under pension arrears. Of the funds received, 37% was for pension arrears, 20% was for pension, 18% was for salaries for the district and urban staff, 10% was gratuity, development was 6% and 7% was for non- wage recurrent activities.

By the end of the quarter, the department had spent 1, 034,297,000 /= which was 118% of the department quarterly release. The department over spent due to the balances brought forward from the previous quarter.

The biggest budget expenditure was on no wage recurrent with 74%, followed by wage for district and urban staff salaries with 16% and 10% was for development activities.

### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The department had unspent balance of 153,246,000/= which was balance under pension, gratuity and salary arrears. The biggest amount of unspent of Shs 100,658,000/= was salary arrears for staff who had not been cleared by MoFPED because they had missing attachments on their claims.

#### Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

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2 monitoring visit was carried out in the 9 LLGs of Galiraya, Bbaale, Kayonza, Kitimbwa, Busaana, Nazigo, Kangulumira, Kayunga sc and Kayunga TC., Coordinated government& donor funded programs to ensure timely submission of 2nd quarter reports and third quarter work plans to responsible authorities. Updated the payroll and website, paid salaries to staff and gratuity arrears to retired staff. Paid for the construction of the foundation level of the southern wing of the district administration block & created awareness about the district activities and programs.

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### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By the end of the December, the department received a cumulative total of 325,697,000/= representing 48% of the department annual budget. Of the funds received, 64% was district urban un conditional grant non wage, 17% wage, 16% as locally raised revenue, 3% was development revenue. Due to overall under collection of local revenue, only 36% was allocated under local revenue and this explains why more allocation (58%) was made under un conditional grant non wage. 45% was allocated under un conditional wage because it was the wage bill for that period. Under development 60% was allocated to cater for transfers to Town Boards to cater for garbage collection and management. Similarly, 36% of the allocated under development non wage because the items for maintenance under IFMS in Q2 were few.

Of the funds received, the department spent a cumulative total of 320,707,000/= which was 48% of the department annual budget. The department spent 50% on non wage. 45% was spent on wage because one staff left for greener pasture. 34% was spent on development activities because we experienced less technical problems with IFMS equipment. implemented recurrent activities included revenue mobilization meetings, business assessment.

In the quarter under review, the department received a total of 174,371,000/= representing 104% of the department quarterly budget. Revenue performance was good because the department received more than 100% under district un conditional grant non wage to under take a study tour for district councilors an activity which was planned to be implemented in quarter three. Of the funds received, 60% was district and urban un conditional grant non wage, 15% was un conditional wage, 14% locally raised revenue and 3% development. By the end of quarter two, the department spent a total of 172,539,000/= which was 99% of the released funds. the biggest expenditure was on non wage recurrent activities with 75%,15% on payment of staff salaries and 10% on development activities

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The un spent balances of 4,990,000/= was meant for IFMs generator operation as we wait for quarter three release.

### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By the end of the first half of the Financial year, the department received a cumulative total of 362,267,000/= representing 52% of the department annual budget. Of the funds received, 47% was locally raised revenue, 27% was district un conditional grant non wage and 26% was un conditional wage. Both Un conditional Non -wage and Wage grants performed below 50% because the expenditure requirements and wage bill for that period was 98,476,000/= and Shs 94,866,000 respectively. Owing to the many activities under local revenue during the period for example payment of council sitting Allowances in arrears, more local revenue 60% was allocated to the Department.

The department spent 52% of its annual budget where by non wage recurrent expenditure was at 54% with activities like council meetings, standing and executive meeting while While wage expenditure was at 49% of the department respective annual grant budget.

In the quarter under review, the department received a total of 155,826,000/= representing 90% of the department quarterly budget. Revenue performance was above average because the district had to funds all council activities since they are mandatory. Of the funds received, 37% was district un conditional grant non wage, 32% was locally raised revenue and 30% was district un conditional grant wage. By the end of second quarter, the department spent 155,826,000/= which was 100% of its quarter releases. where by the biggest expenditure was on non wage recurrent activities with 70% and 30% on payment of staff salaries both technical and political leaders.

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### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By the end of December 2017, the department had received a cumulative total of 264,677,004/= which is 63% of the department annual budget. Out of which 53% was wage for both un conditional wage and agriculture extension wage, 23% was other transfers, 13% was sector conditional development and 12% was sector conditional non wage. The Department received 44% under Unconditional wage because some extension workers were transferred from the Local payroll to Agric. Extension payroll. The department was not allocated local revenue because it had received additional funds of shs 60,039,000 from Ministry of Agriculture for extension work. Note that the said amounts had not been previously budgeted for but we made a supplementary. The department received more development grant (58%) to clear the pending payments for Artificial Insemination.

The department spent accumulative total of 177,087,000/= representing 42% of the department annual budget, The department spent 48% of the annual wage budget, 38% was spent on non wage and 20% was spent on development activities. The department spent less than 50% of its annual budget because the contractor had not yet supplied the agricultural in puts by the end of the second quarter.

During the Quarter under review, the department received a total of 163,301,025/= representing 156% of the quarterly planned budget. Revenue performance was good i.e. more than 100% of the plan because the district received funds as support to agricultural extension services both at the District and LLGs . The department spent 66% of its release where by 45% was spent of payment of salary for district staff and agricultural extension, 14% on non wage recurrent activities while 18% was spent on development projects.

### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

During the quarter a total of 87,590,350/= was not spent by end of December 2017. The recurrent balance was due to spending guidelines that required District Council to pass a supplementary budget (support to agricultural extension services both at the District and LLGs). Other issues that led to unspent balances are technicalities in IFMS. So some of the Q2 funds on the recurrent account was reserved for operation expenses as the district awaits for quarter three release.

#### Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

During the Quarter under review, the Department conducted Stakeholders meeting which drew up all Lower Local Government staffs and sensitized them on the need to profile farmers, groups and institutions. Reviewed all the Data collection forms as prepared by MAAIF and distributed them to staffs (Extension workers, CDOs and Parish Chiefs). Repaired and serviced the Departmental vehicle. Procured and maintained office computer and consumables. Procured and distributed 30,000 African cat fish fingerlings to 9 farmers. Licensed fishers and helped many to process TIN numbers which is a prerequisite for E-fisheries licensing 2018.

Conducted pest and disease surveillance in the crop sector and also trained farmers on irrigation techniques with support from Davis and Shirtliff. Launched Jaguza livestock application for animal tracking (diseases, gestation or theft). Conducted meetings with beekeepers and updated them on new technologies in apiary. Held a meeting of selected LED Actors in the District. Held a turn around meeting with dormant Galiraya SACCO and attended 2 AGM meetings with Cooperatives.

### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By the end of December 2017, the department received a cumulative total of 2,218,731,000/= which is 49% of the department annual budget. Of the funds received 71% was sector conditional grant wage, 18% was donor funds, 10% was sector conditional grant non wage, 0.9% was locally raised revenue and 0.1% was DDDEG funds.

The department had previously not budgeted for Local Revenue. However, an adjustment was made of shs 20,191,000 under Local Revenue to cater for emergency preparations for the fight against suspected cases of Cholera. Besides that, only 43% was allocated under Donor funding because UK-AID had not released fund for Bilharzia program.

Cumulatively, the department spent a total of 2,028,835,000/= which was 45% of the department annual budget. The department spent 50% on payment of staff salaries for both medical officers and health workers on the annual wage budget, 55% was spent on non wage recurrent activities like transfers to District hospital, NGO hospital and Health centre IV-II, 23% was spent on donor development activities and 68% was spent on Development project i.e. payment of retention for the construction of a staff house at Busaana HC III. By the end of the first half of the financial year, the department spent less than 50% because the funds were meant for contract staff salaries under MUWRP whose contracts had expired.

In the quarter under review, the department received a total of 1,102,712,476 representing 57% of the quarter planned revenue. Of the funds received, 71% was PHC wage, 10% was PHC non wage, 17% was donor funds while 2% was locally raised revenue. generally revenue performance was fair because the department received funds under locally raised revenue which was not budgeted to cater for emergencies. The department spent a total of 920,716,018/= which was 83% of the quarter release, where by 71% was spent of payment health workers salaries, 12% was spent on non wage recurrent activities like Monitoring, Inspection and support supervision while 0.3% was spent on development projects i.e. paid retention for construction of staff house at Busaana HC III.

#### Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The department had a balance of 189,896,438/= of which 1,106,424/= was development funds for retention and 188,790,014/= was for payment of contract staff salaries whose contracts had expired.

By the end of the first half of the financial year 20172018, the department received a cumulative to of 8,086,836,000/= representing 48% of the department annual budget. Of the funds received 86% was sector conditional grant wage, 10% was sector un conditional grant non wage, 2% was sector development grant, 0.5% was DDDEG funds, 0.4% was district un conditional grant wage,0.3% was locally raised revenue, 0.3% was other government transfers from central government and 0.3% was district un conditional grant development.

The department received 33% under sector conditional Non Wage because finance did not release funds for quarter two. Local revenue and other transfers from central Government performed above at 50% because more local revenue was provided to cater for Games, Sports and Top-up on PLE supervision expenses. Also, note that what had been budgeted for under other central government transfers was released above the budgeted amount. Under Development, Unconditional non-wage and sector development grants received above 50% to enable the department pay for contractors who had retention funds from completed projects for FY 2016/2017. Similarly, only 24% was allocated under DDDEG because only one project had been completed during the period.

By the end of December 2017, the department spent a cumulative total of 7,655,078,000/= representing 45% of its annual budget. where by 49% was spent on salaries for teachers in Primary secondary and tertiary and staff in the department at the district headquarters while 35% was spent on non wage recurrent activities especially transfer of Capitation grant to primary and secondary schools. The cumulative expenditure was below 50% because the department didn't realize funds for DEO operation and Inspection.

In the quarter under review, the department received 3,623,515,000/= representing 86% of the department quarterly budget. Revenue performance in the quarter was good because the department received 100% of most its grant as the department coordinated PLE activities in the quarter. By the end of the first half of the financial year, the department received a cumulative total of 495,168,224/= which was 57% of the department annual budget. Of the funds received 74% was from central government transfer as URF, 5% district un conditional grant wage, 2% locally raised revenue while 19% was DDDEG.

By the end of December, the department received a cumulative total of 422,861,000/= both wage and non wage representing 35% of the department annual budget. Of the funds received, 76% were other transfer from Central government, 13% was district wage, 9% was sector conditional grant and 1% was locally raised revenue.

The department was not allocated Unconditional Grant as the activities are to be implemented in third Quarter. Wage performed at 47% because what was paid was the actual Wage bill for the period. ### Summary of Workplan Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By the end of December, the department received a cumulative total of 469,210,000/= representing 64% of the department annual budget. Of the funds received, 85% was DDDEG, 5% was urban DDDEG, 5% un conditional grant wage, 3% was un conditional grant non wage and 0.8% was locally raised revenue. Due to under collection of local Revenue, only 14% was allocated to the department. This explains why more Unconditional grant was released to the department to cater for Project appraisals and Budget conference. Wage performed above 50% because what was paid was the exact wage bill for the period. Under Development, both DDDEG at District level and Urban level performed above 50% because the Ministry of Finance released at that percentage to enable the District pay for completed Projects to avoid unspent funds at the year end.

The department spent a cumulative total of 469,210,000/= which was 64% of its annual budget. The biggest percentage expenditure was on development projects with 66% of its annual development budget, this included transfers of DDDEG funds to LLGs, followed by payment of staff salaries with 51% and 50% on non wage recurrent activities. The department spend more than 50% of its annual budget because of the transfer of DDDEG funds to LLGs as the ministry released the highest percentage of development funds to enable the Local Government implement the planned projects and avoid un spent balances by the end of the financial year.

In the quarter under review, the department received a Total of 227,994,000/= representing 124% of the department quarterly budget. Of the funds received 90% was DDDEG funds for the District, LLGS and Urban, 5% was un conditional wage, 3% was un conditional non wage and 2% was locally raised revenue. Revenue performance was more than 100% because the district received more funds under DDDEG to allow the district complete development projects on time. The department spend a total of 236,703,000/= and was over performance because the department spent more than what it received because of the balance brought forward from the previous quarter. Of the total expenditure, 91% was development expenditure like transfers to LLGs and Town council, followed by payment of staff salaries with 5% and 4% was spent on non wage recurrent activities like monitoring, supervision.
