#### Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2024/25

Cumulative receipts; By the end of the period under review, out of the annual Budget of Shs. 15,694,152,000, a total sum of Shs 11,622,282,000 (74%) had been received. Broadly by source, out of the annual Budget of Shs. 2,024,806,000 anticipated to be received as Discretionary Government Transfers, by the end of Quarter three, a total of Shs. 1,596,115,000 (79%) had been received.

Conditional Government Transfers performance stood at shs 9,321,349,000 (77%), out of the planned annual Budget of Ushs 12,069,144,000. Locally Raised Revenue of Ushs. 604,378,000 (43%) was realized against the annual budget of shs 1,400,000,000 and other government transfers cumulative performance stood at shs 97,500,000 (52%) against the annual budget of shs 186,943,000 and external financing of shs 2,940,000 (22%) had been received against the annual budget of shs 13,260,000.

Cumulative disbursement; Out of the funds received by close of quarter three UShs. 11,622,282,000 (100% against actual receipts and 74% against the annual Budget) was released to various Departments. Cumulative Expenditure; The Departments' cumulative expenditure stood at Shs. 10,282,888,000 (88% against releases spent and 66% against the annual budget released. The under absorption was mainly as a result of non expenditure of the Domestic development Funds since the entity was still soliciting contractors.

#### **Cumulative Performance for External Financing**

External Financing performance stood at Ugshs 2,940,000 (22 percent) against the annual budget. The underperformance was attributed to non release of Baylor International (Uganda) funds during the first quarter.
