Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2024/25

Cumulatively, the Municipality received a total of UGX 15,303,805,000 in the first three quarters of the FY. These funds represent 76% which is relatively above the target of 75%. Although this looks good, some sources like locally raised revenue at only 57%, donor funding at only 41% and OGT at only 43%. These funds received were distributed to departments and a total of UGX 13,413,423,000. The Money that remained in unspent is especially for development projects which were still under procurement and uncertified.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

By the end of Quarter3, Mubende Municipal council had cumulatively collected UGX 1,291,284,000 representing only 57%. This low collection is due to delayed completion of the Central Taxi park with stall which we had planned to collect substantial amount. Also the council has failed to collect from Occupational permits due to manpower problems. Even Business licences have not performed as expected due to business closure and other business failure issues. This low collection has greatly affected the council operations especially on planned projects. Council is still enforcing those sources with tenable balances to ensure a good return by the close of the FY.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

By the end of the third quarter of the FY, the Municipal council had received UGX 13,365,064,000 out of the annual revised budget of UGX 16,385,121,000, representing 82% budget outturn. This is above the quarterly target of 75% because of Development grants including USAMID. Generally, the Central Government has fulfilled its obligation in financing the Municipal budget.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

By the end of the third quarter of the FY, only UGX 217,694,000 had been received from other government agencies including URF, UNEB and UWEP. This makes 43% budget outturn, during the third quarter, the entity did not receive funds from URF, which affected the implementation of the Council plan.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

By the end of the two Quarters, the Municipality had received UGX 429,764,000 representing 41% of the Budget. This is meant to kick start the construction of the Biogas project by procuring a wheel loader, sensitization of the community and other software activities

Summary of Department Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By the end of the third quarter, the department had cumulatively received shs. 2,349,980,000 out of the Approved Budget of shs. 3,339,086,000 making an outturn of 70%. This is below target & attributed to low performance of multi sector transfers to LLGs development that was at 40%. The rest of the sources were on target except for Transitional Development Grant that was at 100%.

By the end of the quarter under review, the department had cumulatively spent shs. 1,931,962,000 making a 58% budget absorption against the Approved Budget. Expenditures on wage were at 52%, Non – Wage at 76% and Domestic Development at 25%. Low absorption of domestic development is because payments are based on IPC certified. Expenditures were made on payment of salaries, pension, gratuity, office management, supervision, support to the PDM program, town order, routine monitoring & management of the Municipality.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Shs. 418,019,000 remained on account unspent out of which shs. 118,019,000 was wage awaiting recruitment and shs. 300 million as Transitional Development awaiting procurement processes.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Payment of salaries, advertisements and award of contracts, 9 technical planning committee meetings held, town order maintained, 3 monitoring sessions held and profiling of Households for the Parish Development Model program.

By the end of the third quarter, the department had cumulatively received shs. 223,626,000 out of the approved budget of shs. 464,327,000 making an outturn of 48%. This is below target and attributed to 5% performance of local revenue development and 68% performance of recurrent local revenues which is below the target. Unban Unconditional Grant Non – Wage and Wage were both on target.

By the end of the quarter under review, the department had cumulatively spent shs. 193,883,000 making a 42% budget absorption against the approved budget. Expenditures on wage were at 62%, 61% for non wage and 5% for domestic development. Expenditures were made on payment of salaries, quarterly revenue enhancement activities, collection and sport checks, management of the IFMS, preparation and submission of financial, accountability reports and support to divisions.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Shs. 29,743,000 remained on account unspent out of which shs. 12 million was wage arising out of delayed replacements of the accountant that was promoted and the Senior Accounts Assistant that had recently retired in June, 2024. Shs. 17.2 million was Non-wage for activities done during the quarter under review but payments not made by then.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Three monitoring session of revenue collection and management held, 3 revenue enhancement done, 14 engagements of local leaders in revenue collection and management, assessment of local revenue sources done, management and procedures, enforcement on collection of local revenue sources of Property Tax, Local Service Tax and Trading Licenses done.

By the end of the third quarter, the department had received shs. 224,381,000 out of the Approved Budget of shs. 368,673,000 making an outturn of 61%. The performance is below target and attributed to 43% performance of locally raised revenues. Unban Unconditional Grant Non – Wage and Wage were both on target.

By the end of the quarter under review, the department had spent shs. 196,068,000 making a 53% budget absorption. Expenditures were made on payment of salaries, monitoring of council programs, council meetings, executive & travels for meetings & other engagements.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Summary of Department Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By the end of the third quarter, the department had received shs. 201,412,000 out of the Approved Budget of shs. 279,348,000 & Revised Budget of shs. 292,599,000 making a budget outturn of 72% & 69% respectively. The performance is below target and attributed to 26% performance of locally raised revenues. Unban Unconditional Grant Non – Wage, programme conditional grant wage and Non – wage were all on target.

By the end of the quarter under review, the department had cumulatively spent shs. 198,617,000 making a 71% and 68% budget absorption against the Approved Budget and Revised Budget respectively. Expenditures were made on payment of salaries, sensitization of communities for PDM, training of enterprise groups in EKIBAALO, conducting demonstration farms, immunizations, advisory services, coffee seedlings distribution, provision of agricultural extension & veterinary services.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Shs. 2,795,000 was left on account unspent which was all wage to be consumed at the start of the forthcoming quarter.

Summary of Department Revenues and Expenditure by Source

By the end of the third quarter, the department had received shs. 1,515,794,000 out of the approved budget of shs. 1,768,826,000 making a 86% budget outturn. This performance is above the target and attributed to 100% realization of both External financing and Programme Conditional Grant — Development. Programme conditional Grant wage, Non – Wage and Unban Unconditional Grant Non-wage were all on target except for local revenue that was at 45%.
