The Department had a revised budget of Ushs. 2,439,431,000 for the year and Ushs. for the Second(2nd) quarter and realised Ushs. 720,840,000 which is 118 % of the quarterly budget and 42 % of the annual one. Releases from the Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development performed as follows 53% for recurrent and 32% for Development, however, there was low performance under Local Revenue of only 6%. In regard to expenditure, Ushs. 272,740,000 was spent making it 37.8% of the quarterly budget and 12% of the annual one.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent balance was due to delayed contracting of capital projects under health as a result of delays in procuring services both at the Ministry of Health for HC III at Eastern Division and also Maternity ward extension and water-borne toilet at HC IV for development and for wage, it is due to the supplementary wage sent late in the quarter.
