#### (i) Cummulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

The Locally Raised Revenue receipts of 1.590Billions were realized against Shs.3.043Billions planned 52.3% realization rate by close of Q2. Local service tax, Refuse collection, Liquor licenses, Local Hotel Tax, Liquor licenses, Rent from private entities and Inspection fees performed reasonable well from 52% and above.

#### (ii) Cummulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

Central Government Transfers receipts were received to a tune of Shs. 3.322Billions performing at 38.7% by close of Q2, however this low performance was attributed to the 11% quarter releases from Other Government Transfers with no release from USIMID and NAADS made by close of Q2. On the Government Transfers, performance was 51%. Sources like Local Development Grant, Unconditional and Condition Government Transfers was as expected at shs.101.426millions, 432.902millions and 2,280.824millions respectively.

The quarterly outturn was 186.3 millions (82%), however multisectorial transfers to LLGs and locally riased revenue excelled beyond expectation due to more locally riased revenue was collected beyond the quarterly budget. The quarterly expenditure was 185.6 million (81%), recurrent expenditure excelled because of the over collectoin that was used to finance extra planned activities. The under performance is mainly on other Government transfers (development). These are funds for USMID, CGB, that have not yet been sent by Ministry of Finance. The departmental cumulative receipts were 323.9 millions against the Annual Planned 912.4 millions by close of Q2 representing 36% performance against the standard 50% (Recurrent 314.8 millions (58%) and Development 9.1 millions (2%)).

The quarterly revenue collection was 420 millions (158%) which is beyond the actual quarterly budget, this was due to over performance by recurrent revenues specifically; multisectorial transfer to LLGs, and locally raised revenue, the above performance was a result of over collection from local source beyond the quarterly budget. The quarterly expenditure was 480.1 millions (197%), this was due to transfers made to LLGs that had not been done in the First quarter, the locally raised revenue performance which was high led to financing other activities that were planned in the next quarters. Some sources in development revenue performed below expectation because of the urgency of recurrent expenditures in the quarter thus not making allocations for the development programs. The departmental cumulative receipts were 647.6millions against the Annual Planned 1,062millions by close of Q2 representing 61% performance against the standard 50% (Recurrent 647.6millions (61%) and Development 0millions(0%)).

The departmental cumulative expenditure was 594millions against the Annual Planned 1062millions by close of Q2 representing 56% performance against the standard 50% (Recurrent 594millions (56%) and Development 0millions(0%)).
