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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2025/26

Entebbe Municipal Council received a total of Shillings 22,990,702,000 against the annual Revised budget of Shillings 70,094,231,000 making 33% performance. Under performance was as a result of not realizing Other Government Transfers as planned (mainly Greater Kampala Metropolitan Area Project) hence performing at only 12%. However, Conditional Government Transfers performed at 70% and this was attributed to realizing 100% Transitional Development Funds for Works and Technical services. Additionally, Locally Raised Revenue performed at 56%. Over performance was due to realizing more revenues under other License and LST , Local Hotel Tax and property related at duties at 2395% , 120% , 81% and 75% respectively.

The Cumulative Expenditure Performance for all programs totaled to Shs. 20,199,176,000 making 88% of the cumulative receipts. 17% was spent on payment of staff salaries across all programs, 25% was spent on execution of planned Non- wage activities (Payment of Gratuity, Multi Sectoral Transfers to LLGs, Transfers to UPE and Health facilities, Construction of Drainages among others) and Domestic Development 58% (GKMA Planned activities, Construction of Pre- Financing roads and Uganda Road Fund).

12% was left unspent and it was mainly for payment of Pensioners, Construction of Kiwafu Muslim and Airforce Primary Schools, Renovation of Staff house at Kigungu HC, Fencing of Kigungu Playground Phase II, Rehabilitation of Sebugwawo -Bunono - Abayita Ababiri + Kitinda Link and Re construction Kiwafu- Kitooro roads and Preparation Entebbe Municipal Council Drainage Master Plan.

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Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Entebbe Municipality planned to collect a total of Shs.5,700,000,000 from all Local Revenue sources, by the end of December, the entity was able to realize a total of Shs. 3,208,023,000 representing 56% of the Annual budget. Over performance was due to realizing more revenues under other licenses, LST and Hotel Tax. However, sources like Market Charges performed at only 22% as a result of Kitooro market not operating at 100%, Poor performance of land fees at only 8% finally, failure to collect from vehicle parking at 0%, Rent and Rates Non produced Assets from Private Entities and Educational and refuse collection.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

By the end of quarter Two, Entebbe Municipal Council had received total revenue from Central Government Transfers (Discretionary and Conditional Government Transfers) of Shillings 14,680,730,000 representing 68.7% of the approved budget. Over performance was due to realizing 100% of the Transitional development for works and technical services. However, program Conditional Non - wage performed at 46%.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

By the end of December, Only Shs. 5,101,948,000 was realized as Other Government Transfers (GKMA , IDI and Uganda Road Fund) against the revised Budget of Shs. 43,029,327,000 making only 12%.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

The entity didn't budget for External Financing for the Financial Year 2025/2026.

Summary of Department Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The cumulative release by the end of the quarter two stood at 56% of the approved annual budget. Over performance was in Local Revenue at 62% as more funds were committed to clearing Arrears for catering services, Multi sectoral Transfers to LLGs Nonwage at 76% However, Multi Sectoral Transfers to LLGs Development and Other Government Transfers -GKMA performed at 18% and 28% respectively.

By the end of December, 92% of the received funds was spent on Domestic Development (3%), Nonwage recurrent activities (93%) and Payment of staff salaries (4%).

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

The unspent funds were to cater for payment of salary awaiting recruitment , Pensioners whose beneficiary files were not up to date and execution of Planned activities under GKMA.

Summary of Department Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The department received total revenue of shs. 103,018,000 during the quarter and Shs. 162,161,000 cumulatively representing 37% of the total budget. This revenue comprised of 45.6% wage, 9.2% non-wage, 29.7% local revenue and 15.5% Development. Locally Raised revenue performance of 30% was attributed not realizing the funds as planned.

By the end of Quarter two, the cumulative expenditure was Shs. 137,997,000 leaving a balance of Shs. 24,163,000 unspent.
