Fort Portal City received UGX 7,893,639,000 representing 26% of the approved budget of UGX 30,122,527,000. The least performing source was Discretionary Government Transfers at 10% this was due to the receipt of USMID-AF Grant under Other Government Transfers yet it was budgeted for under Discretionary Government Transfers this also explains the over performance of the Other Government Transfers where a USMID-AF Grant of UGX 1,691,516,000 was received yet it had been budgeted for under Discretionary.

No funds were received under the External Financing category.

Of the total expenditure of UGX 4,341,674,000 representing 14% of the annual budget. Of this UGX 2,479,429,000 (57%) was spent on staff salaries, UGX 1,735,824,000 (40%) on non wage recurrent expenditure and UGX 126,422,000 (3%) on Development expenditure.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

Fort Portal City received UGX 5,339,543,515 in Central Government Transfers against a plan of UGX 7,125,343,659 representing a 74.9% of the Quarterly plan and 20.8% of the annual budget. The poor performance of the Government Transfers is attributed to the cuts in quarterly releases where Government only released a half of the Quarterly non wage grants and also no Development Grants were released in the Quarter. Another reason for the deviation is that the USMID-AF funds were received under Other Government Transfers and yet these were budgeted for under Central Government transfers.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Under Other Government Transfers the City received UGX 1,719,515,959 from URF out of a planned UGX 358,833,231 representing a 118% performance. The overperformance was attributed to the receipt of USMID Development Grant of UGX 1,691,515,959 under OGT yet it was budgeted for under Discretionary Government Transfers.
