Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2025/26

The total approved budget for the financial year was UGX 13.63 billion, later revised to UGX 13.74 billion, of which UGX 3.24 billion (24%) had been received by the reporting period. The main revenue sources were government transfers, which accounted for the bulk of funding. Conditional Government Transfers performed relatively well at 24%, driven mainly by wage recurrent grants (25%) and non-wage recurrent grants (28%), though development grants underperformed at only 3%. Discretionary Government Transfers registered 21% overall, with both wage and non-wage components achieving 25% performance. Locally raised revenues remained low at 23%, with significant underperformance in key sources such as property-related fees, parking fees, and advertisements, all of which had not yet yielded any collections. Only the Local Service Tax achieved full realization at 100%, while business licenses and land fees performed fairly at 55% and 50%, respectively. No funds were received under External Financing and some Other Government Transfers like UWEP and URF. Overall, revenue performance stood at 24%, reflecting slow inflows particularly from local and development funding sources.

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

Locally raised revenues had a total approved and revised budget of UGX 300 million, of which only UGX 67.65 million (23%) had been collected by the reporting period. Performance varied across revenue streams

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

The overall budget performance shows that out of a total allocation of UGX 13.74 billion, about UGX 2.63 billion (19%) had been spent by the reporting period. The largest share of funds was directed towards Human Capital Development, which received UGX 8.68 billion and spent UGX 1.98 billion (23%), reflecting strong implementation progress. Other key sectors such as Public Sector Transformation, Regional Balanced Development, and Private Sector Development also showed fair performance with absorption rates ranging from 17% to 24%. However, Integrated Transport Infrastructure and Services recorded low utilization at only 3%, while Domestic Development funds had not been utilized at all. In terms of expenditure categories, wage recurrent spending performed best at 23%, followed by non-wage recurrent at 18%, while no disbursements were made under external financing and domestic development. This indicates moderate overall budget execution, with room for improvement in development spending.
