Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2023/24

Against the approved budget of shs 34,078,939,000 for FY 2023-2024, shs 39,826,078,000 had been released as at the end of forth quarter translating into 117% performance. Local revenue performance was shs 1,439,388,000(99%),Discretionary Transfers performance was shs 23,278,453,000(126%), Conditional Government Transfers performance was shs 14,822,959,000 (79%), Other Government Transfers performance was shs 261,654,000 (96%) while Donor Funding release was shs 23,625,000 (31%).

Total revenues for the quarter was more that 100% quarterly target because:1)Ministry of FInance released all the budgeted for grants especially wage,Nonwage and the Development and release of the supplementary budget,2)The percentage of performance was computed against the initial budget yet we had a revised budget.

On the otherhand, there was inadequate release of donor funds by the VNG international, Mild may and Baylor.

Total cumulative releases to the departments was shs 39,826,078,000 and shs 38,041,369,000 had been spent as at the end of forth quarter leaving a closing balance of shs 1,784,709,000 on departmental accounts notably Administration, Health,Roads and Engineering. The reason for unspent balances was because:1) The unspent funds under Engineering was mearnt for retention on the completed usmid road works 2) The unspent wage was because of the ban on recruitment.

Out of the total releases, shs 11,272,466,000 was spent on payment of staff salary on all payroll categories, shs 4,549,223,000 was spent on nonwage recurrent activities, shs 22,196,058,000 was spent on domestic development while shs 23,623,000 was spent on donor development.

The approved budget for Central Government Transfers was shs 33,473,077,000 and shs 38,101,412,000 had been release at the end of quater four translating into 117% performance. Over performance was due to adequate release of the sector wage, Nonwage, Development grants and the urban unconditional grants.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

Against the approved budget of shs 271,313,200,shs 261,654,000 had been released as at the end of forth quarter translating into 96%. Under performance was due to non release of funds for TREP activities, inadequate release of UWEP and UNEB funds

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

Against the approved budget of shs75,500,000 for FY 2023-2024,shs 23,625,000 had been released as at the end of forth quarter translating into 31% performance.

Under performance was due to none release of the funds by VNG International and inadquate released of by MSF. This affected revenue enhancement activities and monitoring of HIV/AIDS activities.
