Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2025/26

By the end of quarter one, Lugazi MC had realized a total budget out turn of UGX2,762,155,000 a representation of 23% of the entire approved budget of UGX11,895,711,000 for the FY2025/26. This is 3% less than the expected 25% by close of quarter one.

Receipts from Central Government transfers (only conditional transfers) were fully realized at 25% and the rest ie Discretionary Government Transfers, locally raised revenues and Other Government Transfers were below the quarter expectation that is 20%,22% and 14% respectively. Wage balances reflected under Administration, Finance, Statutory Bodies, Education, CBS, Audit and Trade departments has been as a result of the vacant posts whose recruitment is yet to happen.

Quarter 1

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

The municipal collections for quarter one performed at 22% ie UGX405,913,000 of the planned budget of UGX1,853,457,000. The performance was slightly lower than 25% expected for the quarter and this was due to poor performance of the major sources i.e Business licenses at 6% and Inspection Fees at 0% which calls for better strategies to improve revenue collections during quarter two.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

By the end of the first quarter, Lugazi MC had received a total budget outturn of UGX2,330,351,000 a representation of 22.5% of the total approved budget of UGX9,861,640,000 for the FY2025/2026. This out turn was slightly lower than the expected 25% for the quarter and this was due to non-release of Urban Discretionary Equalisation Development Grant and only 2% of the Programme Conditional Grant – Development.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

By the end of the first quarter, Lugazi MC had only mobilized a total out turn of UGX25,891,000 translating to 14% of the total OGT approved budget of UGX180,614,000 for the FY2025/2026. This was 11% below the expected 25% at the end of the quarter. The non-receipt of funding from GROW Project, UWEP and PLE (meant for 3rd term) affected the estimated budget and planned activities. The receipts were only realized from Uganda Road Fund.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

The vote does not have any external funding.

SECTION B: Summary by Department

By the end of the first quarter, Administration department had realized a total revenue out turn of Ugx682,003,000 translating to 23% of the approved budget of Ugx2,974,880,000 for FY2025/2026. The bulk of the funds was from Locally Raised Revenues at 39%, Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs_Non Wage at 21%, Programme Conditional Grant - Non-Wage Recurrent at 25%, Urban Unconditional Grant Wage at 25%, Urban Unconditional Non-Wage at 25% and Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs_GoU at 0%. Non release of Multi-Sectoral Transfers to LLGs_Gou slightly lowered the overall revenue performance for the department to 23% instead of 25%.

Departmental expenditure was at 20%(Ugx587,198,000) of the total receipts for the department.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Ugx5,903,000 was unspent wage for the Deputy Town Clerk whose recruitment is ongoing. Ugx88,902,000 was unspent non-wage consisting of.

- 1. Pension=Ugx35,662,457 and Gratuity =469,638 that had not been paid by the end of September 2025, the files were still being worked on.
- 2. Ugx1,534,500 was UUG-Nonwage was meant to cater for the operations of the office of the TC whose payment was initiated late towards the end of September.
- 3. Ugx51,235,404 was unspent Local Revenue that was released late as a result of the IRAS system inconsistencies.

- -Staff welfare maintained, home to work, training, monitoring of all municipal activities, meetings and workshops facilitated.

By the end of the first quarter, Statutory Bodies department had realized revenues totaling to Ugx101,886,000 which is 223% of the approved budget of Ugx446,265,000 for FY 2025/2026.

The performance was slightly lower than the expected 25% due to low release of funds (LR at 20%).

Summary of Department Revenues and Expenditure by Source

The Production Department realized a revenue total of Ugx99,724,000 by the end of the First Quarter of FY 2025/2026. This release was 39% of the approved budget of Ugx258,947,000 for the department and this was far beyond the expected quarterly performance of 25%. Higher revenue performance was due to 50% release of both Programme Conditional Grant Non-Wage Recurrent and Development funds and LR at 33%.

Expenditure wise, the department managed to absorb Ugx68,691,000 which was 27% of the total receipts.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Ugx21,365,000 was unspent non-wage that consisted of Ugx15,865,000 due to high release of Programme Conditional Grant - Non-Wage Recurrent to a tune of 50% meant for both 1st and 2nd quarters. It included Housing allowance meant to facilitate the 19 Town Agents and departmental activities for the second quarter. Ugx5,500,000 LR that was also meant for Quarter 2 activities.

Ugx9,668,000 was unspent Development funds waiting for the 2nd quarter release to effect full payments to the contractor of a Stray Animal Holding Ground in Kakubansiri -Butinindi ward of Kawolo Division.

- 1. Paid salaries of 2 male staff for 3 months.
- 2. Carried out Mult stakeholder monitoring of 100 farmers (F=33, M=77) in all 3 divisions of the municipality.

- 7. Paid PDC facilitation to 20 wards.
- 8. Paid Housing Allowance to 19 town agents for the 3 months.
