Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2025/26

Mityana Municipal Council received cumulative receipts amounting to UGX 4,670,134,000 which was 25% against the approved budget of UGX 18,596,663,000 and this was mainly attributed to by 2% performance of Locally Raised Revenues worth UGX 31,984,000 19% performance of Discretionary Government Transfers worth UGX 454,451,000 and 29% of Conditional Government Transfers worth UGX 4,183,699,000. The funds were allocated and warranted across departments. The warranted funds were spent across the different NDPIII adopted programs as follows; Agro-Industrialization at 13%, Tourism Development at 3%, Natural resources, environment, climate change, land and water at 15%, Private sector development at 17%, Integrated transport infrastructure and services at 9%, Digital Transformation at 0%, Human capital development at 22%, Public sector transformation at 14%, Governance and security at 63%, Regional Balanced Development at 9%, and Development plan implementation at 9%. Out of the total approved wage budget of UGX 8,357,872,000, only UGX 1,740,663,000 was spent which was 21% performance, out of UGX 8,398,492,000 of non-wage recurrent, only 1,476,210,000 was spent which was 18% performance and for domestic development, out of the approved budget of UGX 1,840,299,000, only UGX 30,415,000 which was 2% performance.
