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Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2024/25

Cumulatively, the Municipality received a total of UGX 19162532,000 by the end of the FY 2024/25. This represented 95% of the Municipal approved budget. Generally, the central government transfers performed on target, with a slight drop from other government transfers at 98%. The issues were seen in Locally raised revenue performing at only 80%, and External financing at 41%. This low performance was contributed to by the delayed completion of the Taxi Park Lock ups and stalled which had a substantial budget in the Municipal approved Budget. However, for the External Financing, the Project is still ongoing of construction of a biogas plant at Kasenyi SS. We hope the funder will release the funds as the project progresses. Out of the total receipt, UGX 18,610,120,000 was spent representing 98.3% of the total receipt. The remaining balance was left major on wages for delayed recruitments.

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Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

By the end of the FY 2-24/25, the Municipal Council had cumulatively collected UGX 1,827,277,000 out of the approved budget of UGX 2,271,276,000, representing 80% budget outturn. This is lower than estimated because, the cause had expected to collect Money from the USMID projects; Taxi Park Lock up, Market stall and mayor's Gardens, but the Contract over delayed, thus affecting the budget performance. Also, the council budgeted to collect money from Occupation permits as per the building control Act, however delays were met as it required length awareness procedures.

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

By the end of the financial year, the Municipal council had received UGX 16,408,946,000 out of the annual revised budget of UGX 16,408,946,000, representing 100% budget outturn. This was a good budget discipline from the central government.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

By the end of the FY, UGX 496,544,000 had been received from other government agencies including URF, UNEB and UWEP. This makes 98% budget outturn.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

During the fourth Quarter, there was no release for the Biogas project. Much Money had been released by end of third quarter.

By the end of the FY, the department had cumulatively received shs. 3,265,195,000 out of the Approved Budget of shs. 3,339,086,000 making an outturn of 98%. This was below target & attributed to low performance of local revenue collection which couldn't allow allocation of UGX 55,000,000, meant as co-funding for the council building. The rest of the sources were on target. These funds were paid out to the tune of 84% leaving a balance on wage, for those staff who went out of the institutions and the delayed recruitments. The non-wage component represent funds of local revenue collected in June, but had not yet been realized for expenditure by close of the FY.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

UGX 460,253,000 reflect as unspent where UGX 137,361,000 was for wage caused by delayed recruitments, UGX 58,370,000 was on delayed return of Local revenue of June by the Ministry, and UGX 294,522,000 was another component on Local revenue that did not come back on time from the ministry.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Payment of salaries, advertisements and award of contracts, 12 technical planning committee meetings held, town order maintained, 4 monitoring sessions held and profiling of Households for the Parish Development Model program.

By the end of the 4th quarter, the department had cumulatively received shs. 281,722,000 out of the approved budget of shs. 464,327,000 making an outturn of 61%. This is below target & attributed majorly to 5% performance of local revenue development. Unban Unconditional Grant Non – Wage & Wage were both on target except for local revenue recurrent that was at 82%.

By the end of the FY, the department had cumulatively spent shs. 275,102,000 making a 59% budget absorption against the approved budget. Quarterly expenditures were higher than the receipts & this is entirely due to activities carried out in the previous quarters but whose expenditures were made in the quarter under review. Expenditures on wage were at 93%, 86% for Non-Wage & 5% for domestic development. Expenditures were made on payment of salaries, quarterly revenue enhancement activities, collection & sport checks, management of IFMS, preparation & submission of financial, accountability reports & support to divisions.

Reasons for unspent balances on the bank account

Shs. 6,620,000 remained on account unspent which were entirely wage. This rose out of delayed replacement of staff that had transferred services.

Highlights of physical performance by end of the quarter

Four monitoring session of revenue collection and management held, 4 revenue enhancement done, 20 engagements of local leaders in revenue collection and management, assessment of local revenue sources done (trading Licenses, markets and other licenses / operational permits), maintenance of the IFMS, 4 quarterly financial reports made, management and procedures, enforcement on collection of local revenue sources of Property Tax, Local Service Tax and Trading Licenses done.

By the end of the Financial Year, the department had cumulatively spent shs. 345,998,000 making a 94% budget absorption.
