The District overall budget was 31,394,017,000= Out of the budgeted figure, the district managed to receive 16,445,038,000= representing 52% of the budgeted revenue. Locally raised revenues budget performance stood at 63% which was above the expected target of 50%. The increase was mainly due to the revenue which was collected in the last financial year that was carried forward in the current financial year and also the increase was due to the following sources of revenues. Property related duties /fees which stood at 246% followed by Sale of non- produced Government properties /Assets which stood at 155% due to disposal of Government assets followed by Market /gate charges which stood at 151% out of the budgeted figure and this was due to the fact markets were opened up compared to the previous financial year, then followed Business licenses which stood at 84% out of 50% expected, this was due to the fact that many new businesses come up compared to the previous financial year. Another source of revenue which scored highly was Animal and crop Husbandry related levies where 76% was collected out of 50% targeted in the quarter.

Central Government transfers receipts were 15,111,347,000= out of 28,899,275,000= budgeted representing 52.3% of the total budget above the target of 50% of the expected target in the quarter. This was due to following sources of revenue, District unconditional Grant wage where 54% were received out of the budgeted figure, and Programm Conditional grant -Wage where 56% was received out of 50% budgeted on the other hand, Discretionary Equalisation Development Grant, Programme conditional Development grant and Transitional Development Grant 33% was received out of 50%.

Other Government transfers stood at 42% below the expected average of 50% was received. The decrease was due to non-receipt of the following revenues Uganda Women Entrepreneurship Programm (UWEP), Micro Project under Luwero- Rwenzori Development Programme where 10% was received
