Summary of Cumulative Receipts, disbursements and expenditure for FY 2022/23

In Q4 the district cumulatively received Ugx 37.14bn representing 80% revenue performance of the annual budget where local revenue is Ugx 176.2m (117%). Over performance was due to UGIFT and secondary wage supplementary budget. The receipts at respective revenue performance was as; local revnue Ugx210.1m (28%), discretionary government transfers Ugx 2.59bn (79%), conditional government transfers Ugx 33.53bn (131%), other government transfers Ugx 690.64m (57%) and external financing Ugx 213.1m (28%) though no donor funds were received in the quarter. The respective cumulative expenditure and performance was; Administration Ugx 6.7bn (82%), Finance Ugx 283.7m (79%), Statutory Ugx 578.3m (87%), Production Ugx 1.4bn (91%), Health Ugx 4.73bn (87%), Education Ugx 14.6bn (118%), Roads Ugx 1.2bn (83%), Water Ugx 524m (96%), Natural Resources Ugx 246.7m (108%), Community Ugx 233.4m (64%), Planning Ugx 248.5m (89%), Audit Ugx 29.9m (81%) and Trade Ugx 86.95m (98%). The overall cumulative expenditure was Ugx 30.85bn at the performance of 98% of the annual budget. Also expenditure by programme was; Agro Industralisation Ugx 540.9m (76%), Tourism Ugx1.5m (60%), Natural Resources and climate change Ugx 771.6m (100%), private sector development Ugx 12.2m (100%), transport and infrastructure Ugx 1.2bn (83%), Human capital Ugx 19.72bn (108%), public sector transformation Ugx 5.12bn (72%), Governance and Security Ugx 1.8bn (131%), Development Plan Implementation Ugx 1.6bn (85%).

Cumulative Performance for Locally Raised Revenues

In Quarter 4 the district received Ugx 33.9m mainly from land fees and market collections. This represented 18.4% of the expected quarter collections and 4.6% of the local revenue annual budget. Cumulatively the local revenue collected was Ugx 210.1m representing 28.45% of the annual budget. This clearly shows that the district was not able to collect even 50% of the projected local revenue due to lost revenue bases to the city, unmapped revenue sources, limited political support and COVID-19 distortionary effects

Cumulative Performance for Central Government Transfers

The district received Ugx 11.6bn representing 181.5% revenue performance of central conditional funds quarter budget. Cumulatively, the district received Ugx 33.43 representing revenue performance of 130.5% of the annual budget. The over performance is due wage supplementary funds that were appropriated and received in the quarter especially for health and education sector under Human Capital programme. With discretionary funds; The district received Ugx 1.94 bn representing 236.49% quarter revenue performance of discretionary funds. Cumulatively the discretionary funds received amounts to Ugx 4.5bn over and above the annual budget giving the revenue performance of 138.1% of the annual budget. These funds were transitional and conditional development grants of UGIFT for the seed school, health and education sector projects.

Cumulative Performance for Other Government Transfers

In Q4 the district received Ugx 115.96m of other government transfers. This was representative of 38.39% of the quarter budget line budget. Cumulatively, the district received Ugx 690.64m of other government transfers representing 57.2% of the annual budget. This came from URF, UWEP, YLP for roads routine works and supervision of welfare enhancing projects under OPM.

Cumulative Performance for External Financing

In Q4 the district did not receive any funds as per the donor funds budget. These were expected from UNICEF, TASO, GAVI, WHO, Global fund for HIV, TB and Malaria respectively for immunisation and primary health care. This has affected the planned activities and the expected budget performance level.
