MAPPING NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN (NDP III) INTERVENTIONS TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT VOTE STRUCTURE

Reference is made to our letter ref. BPD 86/107/01 dated 29th October, 2020 through which you were requested to prepare your Budget Framework papers for FY 2021/22 in alignment with information provided in the Program Implementation Plans (PIPs) in terms of Sub-programs, Intermediate outcomes and Indicators. For ease of alignment of the Budget Framework Paper to the National Development Plan (NDP III), a Microsoft word template was shared.

To date, however, only 7 out of 176 Local Governments have populated the template submitting their draft Budget Framework Papers for FY 2021/22. The key main challenge noted has arisen from failure to align the NDP III Indicators to the Departments as per the organizational structure of Local Governments. While undertaking this exercise, the Department with the highest number of NDP III Programme specific interventions has been proposed to host the salary budget accruing to the programme.

The purpose of this letter, therefore, is to communicate to you the hereto attached matrix mapping NDPII interventions to various Departments under Organizational Structure of Local Governments for your use. **You should submit your Budget Framework Papers for FY 2021/22 by C.O.B Friday, 4th December, 2020 without fail.**
