Matters to note in budget execution

The biggest challenge in service delivery has been the inadequate budget for health facilities from the level of Health Centre IV to National Referral Hospitals. The sustained depreciation of the shillings against major international currencies like the USD dollar and Euro has led to less supplies being procured from the same budget allocation. This is very evident with framework contracts that are denominated in USD dollar. The exchange volatility has mostly affected Uganda Blood Transfusion Services whose annual budget was wiped out in the first quarter of the FY 2016/17. There is minimal variance when comparing the released funds and the expenditure. Out of UGX 212 billion that had been released by Quarter 3 for FY 2016/17, only UGX 1.7million had not been paid out to suppliers by end of Quarter three.
