ADDITIONAL LOCAL GOVERNMENT QUARTER THREE (Q3) EXPENDITURE LIMITS FOR LOCAL REVENUE FOR FY 2020/21

Reference is made to the Circular Ref: MET.50/268/01 dated 16th December 2020, communicating Quarter Three Expenditure Limits for FY 2020/21 for all Budget categories. Further reference is made to the several correspondences from most of you requesting for Local Revenue Expenditure limits to enable you undertake various activities in your respective Local Governments during FY 2020/21.

The release for Local Revenue is based on remittances to the Consolidated Fund. As such, consideration has been made only for those Local Governments whose recovery levels were above 100% of the respective cumulative advanced Local Revenue Cash Limits as per the Accountant General's report for the period ending 31st December, 2020.

Following our analysis and confirmation that your additional remittances to the holding Account at Bank of Uganda are over and above the funds so far advanced to your respective Votes, the Ministry has considered 20% of your Local Revenue budget for FY 2020/21 plus any outstanding balances of remittances in excess of your Q1 and Q2 Local Revenue Cash Limits.

In light of the above, I have therefore authorized additional Quarter Three (Q3) Expenditure Limits amounting to UShs.23,125,436,005/= (Twenty Three Billion, One Hundred Twenty Five Million Four Hundred Thirty Six Thousand Five shillings only).

You are therefore requested to immediately submit a breakdown of the above funds by category (whether Non-wage Recurrent or Development) in line with your Approved Budget, to facilitate upload on the IFMS, after which you will be required to submit your Accounting warrants up to the ceilings communicated. The above breakdown should be sent to bped@finance.go.ug by Monday, 11th January 2021. Local Governments that will not adhere to the above deadline will have their Expenditure Limits lumped under the Non-Wage budget category.
