FOURTH QUARTER (APRIL - JUNE 2015) RELEASE FOR NON WAGE RECURRENT CONDITIONAL GRANT TRANSFERS TO DISTRICTS AND MUNICIPAL COUNCILS – FY 2014/15

- 1. Please find attached the release schedule for Non-Wage Recurrent grants transfers to Local Governments for the Fourth Quarter (April June 2015) for FY 2014/15.
- 2. This release circular caters for only those conditional grants which are released to the General Fund Account at a District/Municipal vote level. These grants are;
 - i) IFMS Operational Costs
 - ii) IPPS Operational Costs
 - iii) District Unconditional Grant Non Wage
 - iv) Urban Unconditional Grant Non Wage
 - v) Start Up Costs
 - vi) District Equalization Grant
 - vii) Urban Equalization Grant
 - viii) Production and Marketing Grant incl. Commercial services
 - ix) Functional Adult Literacy
 - x) Boards and Commissions
 - xi) Urban Water O&M Grant
 - xii) PAF Monitoring and Accountability Grant
 - xiii) Public Libraries Board
 - xiv) Community Development Workers
 - xv) Environment and Natural Resources
 - xvi) Youth Women and Disability Councils
 - xvii) District Service Commission Operational Costs
 - xviii) Councilors Allowances (Excluding Ex-Gratia)
 - xix) Special Grant for People with Disabilities
 - xx) Sanitation and Hygiene Grant- Water Component

- 3. The grants which are released directly to the beneficiary institution accounts such as Town Councils, UPE and USE schools, General Hospitals, Health Units, NGO Hospitals and other tertiary institutions have been effected under a separate schedule.
- 4. Salaries will continue to be paid directly to the individual bank accounts on a monthly basis in line with the guidelines for Decentralised Salary Payment System. You are required to ensure timely validation of the payrolls, submission of payment invoices, reconciliation of bank accounts and resolution of unapplied EFTs, among others, to facilitate timely payment of salaries.
- The release against item 321424 Urban Water (Operation and Maintenance) under this circular caters for only those urban water sources which have not yet attained a Town Council Status, the details of which are attached as Annex 1b. The Accounting Officers for the mentioned Local Governments are instructed to transfer these funds intact to the beneficiary urban water sources as well as financing the intervention under the Umbrella programme.
- 6. The release of funds for the urban water sources which are under established Town Councils has been released directly to the beneficiary water sources under a separate schedule. In line with the guidelines for direct transfers to beneficiary accounts, it is your responsibility to follow-up and ensure that the funds are properly utilized and accounted for.
- 7. I have also attached a schedule providing the detailed breakdown for the nonwage conditional grants which have the Normal and PRDP components, as **Annex 2b**, for your ease of reference, for the PRDP local governments.
- A total of UShs. 8,059,740,000/= (Eight Billion, Fifty Nine Million, Seven Hundred Forty Thousand Shillings Only) has been released for item 321445 - Ex-Gratia and Allowances for Elected Political Leaders to Local Governments as follows:
 - i). The District and Municipal Councillors of UShs. 100,000 each;
 - ii). The District and Municipal LC I and LC II Chairpersons of **UShs. 120,000** each;
 - iii). The Municipal Speakers each at **Ushs. 300,000**; and
 - iv). The District and Municipal Deputy Speakers of Ushs. 200,000 each.
- 9. Gratuity for the eligible District Executive Committee members, Chairpersons of District Service Commissions as well as the LCIII Chairpersons will be released as part of their salary for the month of May 2015.
- 10. The total funds released through this circular to the Districts and Municipalities amounts to Ushs: 37,583,385,593/= (Uganda Shillings: Thirty Seven



Billion, Five Hundred Eighty Three Million, Three Hundred Eighty Five Thousand, Five Hundred Ninety Three Only).

- 11. You are reminded to submit your Local Government Budget Performance Progress Report for Quarter Three of FY 2014/15 by **the last working day of April 2015** which will be the basis for quarter one release for FY 2015/16.
- 12. Acknowledgement of receipt of funds released should be sent to this Ministry, addressed to the Permanent Secretary/Secretary to the Treasury for the attention of the Accountant-General, within one month.
