## 2.0 Work plans and Accountability

- 2.1 All Accounting Officers are advised to utilize the funds released under this circular in accordance with quarterly work plans as specified under the appointment letters for Accounting Officers and the Performance Contracts signed with the Permanent Secretary/Secretary to the Treasury in line with the provisions of the Public Finance Management Act, 2015.
- 2.2 For Central Government votes, accountability from Project Managers should continue to be submitted to the respective Accounting Officers with three copies to this Ministry one for the attention of the Director Budget; the other two to the Ag. Internal Auditor General and the Ag. Commissioner/Treasury Inspectorate and Policy Department.

- i) UShs. 50,520,378,000/= (Uganda Shillings: Fifty Billion, Five Hundred Twenty Million, Three Hundred Seventy Eight Thousand Only) will be credited on the Local Governments' General Fund Accounts for the projects of LGMSD, Health Development, Water and Environment Development, Roads Development and SFG component of Education Development; and
- The balance of UShs. 1,771,600,000/= (Uganda Shillings: One Billion, Seven Hundred Seventy One Million, Six Hundred Thousand Only), which is for Secondary School Construction component of the Education Development Grant (Proj Code 1214, item 321370) will be sent directly to the beneficiary schools, based on the advice by Ministry of Education and Sports. I have attached the details by vote and school, under Annex 3, for your ease of reference,
- Whereas the funds in 5.1 (ii) above will remitted directly to the service delivery units, the Local Government Accounting Officers are personally liable for effective utilization of these funds, submission of performance progress reports as well as the accountability of the funds.
  - The Local Government release referred to under para 5.1 above excludes the funds for Project 1255, Item 321465: Urban Municipal Infrastructure Support Project (USMID) which will be released under a separate schedule by Ministry of Lands, Housing and Urban Development; and
  - I have attached **(under Annex 4)** a schedule of the breakdown of the funds released to local governments under each Sector Development Grant, including 'of which' allocations to pre-existing transfers and their PRDP components for ease of ascertaining the details of these releases.
