Reference is made to our letter of even reference dated 7th March 2019 to al! Local Government Accounting Officers on the above subject.

As you are aware, Government commenced the phased withdrawal from the Public Private Partnership under the USEAPOLET program in FY 2017:18, starting with S1 and S5 and to end with S4 in this FY 2019/20. Unfortunately, the Ministry continues to receive several requests from Local Government Accounting. Officers and Headteachers to retain some schools on the USE programme under the same arrangement.

This is to inform you again that the final cohort under the USE Program under the PPP arrangement was budgeted for in this FY 2019/20. Therefore, no school will be considered under a similar arrangement in subsequent Financial Years as the policy is universally applied.
