**REQUEST FOR ACCOUNTABILITY OF PRIMARY HEALTH CARE (PHC)  
DEVELOPMENT FUNDS FROM FY 2017/18 TO DATE**

This Ministry has over the years released funds to your respective Votes for Primary Health Care Development (PHC) to undertake a number of activities under the Health Sub programme.

However, I note with concern that these funds are not properly accounted for contrary to Section 15 of the Public Finance Management Regulations, 2016 which requires an Accounting Officer to submit an annual performance report on the activities of the Vote and the execution of the budget to Secretary to the Treasury.

The purpose of this letter therefore, is to request you to submit all accountabilities of Primary Health Care Development funds received for the last **six** years from FY 2017/18 to- date including physical outputs achieved for the corresponding funds **by 23<sup>rd</sup> December, 2022 without fail.**

**Please note that, this will be a condition for future financing of your budgets for FY 2023/24 and over the medium term, among others.**
