## SUBMISSION OF SECTOR BUDGET FRAMEWORK PAPERS FY 2019/20- FY 2023/24 TO PARLIAMENT

Section 9(5) of the PFM Act 2015, requires the Minister of Finance, Planning and Economic Development to lay before Parliament the National Budget Framework Paper. Accordingly, I have laid the National Budget Framework Paper (NBFP) for FY 2019/20 - FY 2023/24 in Parliament in accordance with the Law.

As you are aware, the NBFP Summarises the Government's Medium Term Macroeconomic Plan and Fiscal Framework as well as the Resource envelope, Policy Measures and Medium Term Expenditure Framework. On the other hand, details of Sector Policy Objectives and Strategic interventions are contained in the Therefore, in order to provide a comprehensive picture of Government Strategic Objectives and the link between outcomes, outputs and expenditure priorities, it is imperative that Sector BFPs should be submitted to Parliament to facilitate discussions in the various Committees.

The purpose of this letter therefore, is to request all Sector Ministers to submit their respective Sector Budget Framework Papers for FY 2019/20 - FY 2023/24 to Parliament not later than 31st December 2018.
