SUPPLEMENTARY FUNDING FOR COVID EMERGENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR FY 2021/22

- 1. Section 25 of the Public Finance Management (Amendment) Act (2015) states that:
 - (1) The total supplementary expenditure that requires additional resources over and above what is approved by Parliament, shall not exceed 3% of the total approved budget for that financial year, without approval of Parliament. (2) Where funds are expended under subsection (1), supplementary estimates showing the sums spent shall be laid before Parliament within four months after the money is spent.
- 2. Cabinet approved a total of Ushs 600 Billion for Supplementary expenditure of which **Ushs 371.7 Billion** will finance COVID-19 interventions under various institutions in Quarter 1 as well as **Ushs 228.3 Billion** approved to cater for Contingencies in FY 2021/22 as detailed below:
