1. Reference is made to the ongoing alignment of the Budget to the 18 NDPIII Programmes. In order to facilitate a smooth alignment process, the Ministry, working with National Planning Authority (NPA) is in the process of acquiring Technical Assistance (TA) from the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP).
2. The TA will focus on capacity building in the areas of planning, budgeting, monitoring and evaluation, as well as finalization of the strategic plans for MALGs that are consistent with the Programme Implementation Action Plans (PIAPs).
