#### Matters to note in budget execution

#### Recurrent Wage

The quarter one release for wage (UGX 17.776Bn) was not fully absorbed by end of the quarter due to the delays in recruitment. Absorption was at 91.4% as per Table V1.1. UNRA had targeted to recruit over 1,471 staff members however; we have been able to recruit only 1,317 staff members. The recruitment is still ongoing, adverts have been ran and we expect by end of quarter two to have reached over 1,400 levels of staff.

#### Unremitted RBS employee contribution;

Included within the unabsorbed wage bill (UGX 1.524Bn) are unremitted employee RBS contributions amounting to UGX 732.9m for 1,141 staff members registered on the scheme. This contribution has not yet been remitted because UNRA is in the process of setting up an independent bank account for the RBS. The bank account is expected to be set up in quarter two.

#### Recurrent Non-wage;

There was significant absorption (above 90% absorption) on a number of item lines under Recurrent Non-wage. However, slow funds absorption has been evidenced on the following line items for the respective reasons listed below;

1) Gratuity: The release for Gratuity by MOFPED is on a quarterly basis and is not in line with the actual UNRA requirement. The majority of the staff members become eligible for gratuity payments within quarter two. We therefore expect the bulk of the payment to be triggered in quarter

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two.

2) Medical: The existing medical contract expired end of June 2017. Procurement of additional service providers for medical insurance services was not completed on time.

3)Maintenance of vehicles: The under absorption of funds for vehicle maintenance is attributed to the delay by the service providers in invoicing UNRA.

#### Development GoU;

Whereas there was 100% funds absorption on some development projects, on others, UNRA experienced slow progress due to the following factors;

- 1) The lengthy land acquisition processes which include display and verification exercises that are prerequisites prior to the commencement of compensation of Project Affected Persons after approval of the Valuation report. This significantly hinders the achievement of set targets.
- 2) Court cases resulting from conflict of land ownership has also delayed progress on road construction. For instance along the Kampala Jinja Expressway where there has been a land ownership conflict between the Chwa family and the Buganda Land Board resulting in the halting of payments as well as progress. In addition, UNRA has experienced challenges with Project Affected Persons that don't accept the Government's land valuations and opt to drag us to courts of law. Such challenges affect project progress and consequently budget absorption.
- 3) A number of contractors have experienced challenges in setting up local currency accounts which hinders UNRA's ability to effect payments due to them. In addition, there have been instances of mismatches whereby the names of the contractors on the invoices differ from the names in the signed contracts with UNRA and this has led to delays in payments. We continue to advise that if the consultant is willing to meet the foreign exchange cost, we shall pay the current USD equivalent as a short term measure.

Some of the projects run out of funds during the quarter since priority in allocation of quarter one cash limit was to settle arrears of the previous FY. 95% of the arrears have been cleared except for those projects whose budgets were exhausted.

#### Development External Financing;

The under absorption of Budget from Development partners is attributed to the following;

- 1) The quarterly release by MOFPED is based on a percentage of the approved budget and is not in accordance to the actual cash flow requirement from UNRA for the quarter.
- 2) Over UGX 1 Trillion was budgeted for the oil roads however all these roads are still under procurement and they are expected to commence in the third quarter.
- 3) The prolonged procurement process requiring a no objection from the development partners at each stage of procurement plus due diligence required.
- 4) MOFPED approves the budget for Development Partners for UNRA that includes budget amounts from loans that have not yet been signed a case in example is the Critical Oil roads with a budget amounting to UGX 1 Trillion.

#### Note

- 1) We have revised work plans for only 9 projects where revisions were needed. Where no revisions were required, these have been left blank.
- 2) The cash limit for external financing for quarter one was not warranted in the IFMS system since some externally financed projects have not yet been activated in IFMS by Finance however we have included a warrant for the projects with the external financing within the system.
- 3) Under the warranted external financing, it can be noted that for the Design of the Nile Bridge the financing ratios were changed from the initial 53% and now JICA is funding 100% of the project. The expenditure is therefore above what was budgeted for.

#### Performance highlights for the Quarter

- 1) UNRA commissioned the Fortportal Kamwenge road project which is meant to foster economic growth in the western region.
- 2) UNRA has completed designs for a number of road projects using its in-house design team including FortPortal -Kyenjojo (50km) and Katunguru-Ishaka (60 km) and works have commenced. This has significantly cut down costs of using consultants to design road projects.
- 3) Procurement for the contractor on Bumboi-Lwakhakha was completed and contracts were signed. Physical works on the project have commenced.
- 4) The procurement of the contractor for the duo carriage way for Busega-Mpigi which will reduce traffic congestions was commenced in the quarter.
- 5) Grievance management committees have been setup on a number of projects to educate surrounding communities on how to examine project progress which increases vigilance and accountability and allows communities participate in the road projects implementation and therefore encourage community project acceptance.
- 6) A number of equipments including 18 Tipper trucks, grader implements, caterpillar, Komatsu, 6 water trucks and 4 cargo cranes among others were procured. The equipments were commissioned and flagged off to stations as a way of increasing capacity to carry out in-house road maintenance and reduce bottlenecks in traffic especially in areas that were affected by floods. These equipments will be deployed to a number of road maintenance interventions that include the restoration of roads cut off by floods and landslides, washed away bridges and other emergencies as they arise.
