At that consumption rate, the total annual projection on power bills is **Ushs 960 m** against the available budget of **Ushs 50m**. If this is to continue, the institute will this financial year accrue electricity arrears to a tune of **Ushs 910,000,000/=**

Inadequate operation funds for the institute: With a recurrent non-wage of Ushs 511 million, the institute can barely support the departments to

effectively and comprehensively carry out research let alone support the general administration of the institute.

Inadequate funding for disease Surveillance: the funding availed to UVRI is too low to support effective and elaborate disease surveillance.
