#### Matters to note in budget execution

REA is faced with a number of challenges that tend to have significant impact on its ability to undertake its mandate and these include:

- Withholding remmittance of 5% Transmission Levy by UETCL. UETCL has not made any remittances to REA for the period March 2017 to date claiming that Umeme is withholding payments to them on account of nonpayment of bills by Government Ministries, Departments and Agencies. This has greatly affected service delivery because REA has no funds for undertaking supervision of various donor funded projects under implementation and salaries to sataff.
- Indequate releases from the Consolidated Fund by MoFPED despite the funds have been Budgeted for. Out of the appropriated GoU
  Development budget of UGX 81.976 billion, REA has only received UGX 25.55 billion for quarter 1-Quarter 3 of the FY2017/18. This is
  31.2% of the total appropriated budget for the year.
