### Matters to note in budget execution

During FY 2018/19, Parliament approved a total budget of **Shs. 7.377 Bn** out of which, **Ushs. 1.541 Bn** was for wage, **shs 5.176** Bn for non-wage, **shs 400m** for Development, and **Shs 260m** for non-tax revenue. By end of Quarter one, **Shs 1.668Bn** had been released representing 22.6% of the approved budget. Out of the released funds, **Shs 0.895Bn** had been spent representing a **53.6%** absorption rate. This low absorption rate is due to: Requisitions are at various stages of procurement including bidding, evaluation, Contracts Committee and engagement of contractors on a commitment basis and encumbrances; wage balances await recruitment by HSC to fill the vacant posts and; Pension balances await approval of pending files by Ministry of Public Service.
