The biggest challenge faced during execution of the budget was the sustained depreciation of the Uganda shillings against major international currencies especially the USD dollar. This volatility of foreign exchange caused less medicines to be received from the small amount of money where contracts for their supply are denominated in USD dollars. This has culminated into bloated accounts payables.
