There was a delayed procurement process for the weather radar due to delayed harmonisation of the radar site in Lira.

41 rain gauges were not procured since some other complimentary instruments were critically needed hence funds utilised to procure these critical instruments which included 25 rain bottles, 60 measuring cylinders, 4 hook gauges and 4 micro gauges. Some weather stations were not reequipped with thermometers, weather sensors, evaporation pans, anemometers, and wind vanes due to insufficient receipt of funds.

Weather balloons and radiosondes were not procured since there was enough stock and funds were used to top-up procurement for the second weather radar.

Community based Automatic weather stations in Kumi municipality and Budaka were vandalised and not reactivated. Kachumbala,Ntusi,Mityana,Kakooge-Nabisweera, Hoima, Apac Community based Automatic weather stations were not reactivated due to insufficient receipt of funds. Stations of Kotido, Kiige and Rakai were not reactivated due to insufficient receipt of funds. Community based Automatic weather stations of Kamuli, Agoro,and Amuru that weren't initially planned for were reactivated to replace Kumi municipality and Budaka stations. 2 extra manual weather stations were maintained due to reactivation of Kalengere and Ikulwe.

Sought a no objection from the districts to relocate the stations to new weather sites for Agrometeorological stations of Ikulwe,Nabwin, Ivukula hence couldn't be rehabilitated in the financial year. Stations of Wadelai and Kibanda are awaiting delivery and installation of uniports for them to be reactivated.

Tororo and Mbarara Zonal offices rehabilitation were not carried out since they required more funds than received.

The bus for Airport operations broke down beyond repair and there was urgent need for replacement hence traded off the two pickups for a bus and 1 extra motorcycle was procured to cater for more hard to reach areas.

19 rain gauges, 60 measuring cylinders, 25 rain bottles, 4 hook gauges,4 micro gauge were procured. 6 Weather stations reequipped with calibrated digital barometers.
