#### Performance highlights for the Quarter

Followed up Viral disease outbreaks (Yellow Fever and Rift Valley Fever).

Continued to review and develop new protocols for new vaccine trials.

Quickly diagnosed Yellow Fever and Ebola cases.133 Influenza samples were collected and diagnosed.

Analyzed and prepared a baseline report on Prevention Mother to child transmission (PMTCT) Impact evaluation in 206 health facilities in Uganda.

Uganda Virus Research Institute (UVRI) Research Ethics Committee reviewed a protocol on Measuring adult health and mortality in the greater Rakai region.

The Expanded Program on Immunization (EPI) I laboratory received and tested 1482 stool samples from Acute Flaccid Paralysis (AFP) cases from five different countries: (Burundi: 44, South Sudan 552, Rwanda 54, Tanzania 523 and 309 from Uganda) and 91% of the results were reported in time(target is reporting 80% in time). No wild polio virus nor vaccine-derived polio virus was detected in any of the stools.

Expanded Program on Immunization (EPI) laboratory tested 336 serum samples collected from suspected measles cases. Measles was confirmed in 143(42.6%) and rubella in 69(21.8%) cases. Three out of the confirmed 7 measles outbreaks were followed up for the collection of samples for virus isolation and characterization.

Expanded Program on Immunization (EPI) laboratory investigated 10 suspected congenital rubella syndrome (CRS) cases, of which six were confirmed to have congenital rubella syndrome.

Performed HIV resistance testing for patients failing on 2nd line ART.

Identified and retrieved samples from young pregnant teenage women for studying trends of Hep B in this population.

Support supervision was provided to 178 testers in 52 facilities located in 13 districts.

915 patients were given medical care at expanded Program on Immunization UVRI Clinic while 204 women received short term family planning methods.

UVRI Clinic carried out counseling, testing for HIV and Other laboratory tests involving 714 clients.
