#### **QUARTER 2: Highlights of Vote Performance**

1.Undertook mission to Changsha Hunan province to follow up on implementation of MoU signed in in June 2019 and conduct due diligence of some enterprises desirous to cooperate with Uganda. The provincial government has I identified another enterprise Hunan Lugu medical Industrial park group to lead the development of the Uganda Hunan Industrial park and the latter will undertake exploratory visits to Uganda to follow up the land offer by government.

- 2.
