During the FY 2020/21 Parliament approved a total budget of shs 8.971bn comprising of shs 1.541 bn for wage, shs 5.150bn for Non-Wage and shs 2.28bn for Development. Out of the total approved budget shs 1.851bn was released by 30th September2020, representing 20.6% of approved budget released. Low absorption rate was noted on Development this is because of delays in awarding a contract due to delayed BOQs. Some reagents are procured outside the country which caused some delays in delivery.
