Matters to note in budget execution

The Bureau has faced a number of challenges especially in data collection activities following the Covid-19 outbreak. There have been additional costs in terms of SoPs that had not been planned for.

The decision also by government not release funds on workshops, has affected some of the planned workshops, which would still be undertaken virtually but would require some costs in terms of allowances and data bundles, that can now not be undertaken.

The other challenges faced by the Bureau was the reduction in the MTEF ceiling for FY2021/22 despite the planned conduct of the National Population & Housing Census in 2022. Also following the outbreak of the COVID19- pandemic the Bureau lost two staff in the Directorate of Macro Economics involved in the production of the Consumer Price Index which impacted on Staff morale and continuity of Bureau Business.

In addition to that was failure to obtain resources for the National Livestock Census 2020 and it is our hope that the Ministry will consider providing some resources this activity.

The Bureau appeals that the Ministry considers providing resources for the planned conduct of the National Population and Housing Census in 2022 and to provide additional resources for the conduct of the National Livestock Census.

Performance highlights for the Quarter

The Board held all the meetings, and the specific Board Committees were also inaugurated.

The Bureau compiled and disseminated the Consumer Price Index for October, November, and December 2020. The Annual Headline Inflation for the Calendar Year 2020 was recorded at 3.8 percent from the 2.91 percent registered for the Calendar year 2019. On a monthly basis the Annual Headline Inflation for the year ending December 2020 was recorded at 3.6 percent compared to the 3.7 percent registered for the year ended November 2020. The Bureau also compiled and disseminated the quarterly growth figures for Q1 of FY2020/21 showing the economic to have contracted by 2.2 percent compared to the growth of 8.7 percent (revised) registered in Q1 of FY2019/20.

The Bureau also compiled the final CPI rebased series which were peer reviewed by a team of experts in the region with support from the African Development bank. With respect to surveys, the Bureau finalised data collection for the 2019/20 Uganda National Household Survey, disseminated key findings of the Uganda National Panel Survey Wave 8, the last in the series of Panel Surveys, and also disseminated the maiden Food Balance Sheet for Uganda. The conduct of other surveys and censuses continued despite the COVID-19 pandemic with staff provided with masks, sanitisers, and encouraged to embrace the Sop's at all times.

The draft Strategic Plan for Statistics was compiled, support provided to MDAs, LGs and CSOs in the production specific SPS aligned to the NDP III. The Bureau also initiated a partnership with the Bunyoro Kingdom aimed at establishing a Statistics function in the Kingdom.

The Bureau recruited two Senior Officers and 11 Statisticians to support the Coordination of the national Statistics system, also celebrated the 2020 Africa Statistics week with several virtual disseminations including among others the launch of the Client Charter. The Bureau also continued to embrace the 30 percent work capacity and the Bureau took back ownership of a section of Entebbe Offices previous occupied by the Special Force Command of the UPDF. The Bureau also held the end of year Annual General Staff meeting virtually before closing for the Christmas holidays.

The overall Absorption for the Bureau was approximately 63.4%; The Bureau also finalised estimates for FY2021/22 totalling UGX 300.88Bn, UGX259.70Bn from GOU and UGX41.6Bn External Financing. The Bureau also appeared before the Office of the Auditor General to respond to issues in the End of Year Audit for FY 2019/20.
