(2) Pharmaceutical Products.
(a) The Ministry through NMS procured and distributed pharmaceutical products worth Ushs 482m to 156 UPDF health facilities. Civilian patients also access and utilize health services and pharmaceutical supplies from UPDF health facilities. As a result, there is a budget shortfall on pharmaceutical supplies worth Ushs2.2bn.

(b) A procurement of essential drugs, sundries and laboratory consumables worth Ushs 101m not supplied by NMS was made. Furthermore, a payment of Ushs 118.3m was made in Quarter 3 for purchase of emergency and lifesaving drugs not supplied by NMS leaving an outstanding debt of Ushs 223.7m.

(3) COVID-19 Pandemic. Disinfection chemicals and IPC materials were distributed to formations and units. There was creation of COVID - 19 awareness through continuous sensitization in formations and units by health workers and Commanders as well as supervision of COVID - 19 operations in health facilities, border points and training schools. Additionally, 22,596 personnel received the first dose of the COVID vaccine. The COVID - 19 vaccination process required cold chain equipment, social mobilization & sensitization and logistical requirements at a cost of Ushs 734.2m. However, there are bills for COVID - 19 prevention materials (IPC materials, EPI Tents and accessories, chemicals and sanitary requirements) worth Ushs 802m pending availability of funds.
