#### Matters to note in budget execution

The Bureau has faced a number of challenges especially in data collection activities following the Covid-19 outbreak. There have been additional costs in terms of SoPs that had not been planned for.

The decision also by government not release funds on workshops, has affected some of the planned workshops, which would still be undertaken virtually but would require some costs in terms of allowances and data bundles, that can now not be undertaken.

Overall, COVID-19 Pandemic delayed implementation of some programs and has instilled fear in some of the respondents and among staff following the demise of two senior staff due to COVID-19.

### Performance highlights for the Quarter

#### **QUARTER 3: Highlights of Vote Performance**

The period Quarter one to Quarter Three of FY20120/21 was characterized by a slowdown in activity implementation following outbreak of the COVID-19 Pandemic. For continued operations, the Bureau embraced the Standard Operating Procedures (SoPs), maintained a staff working capacity of 30%, developed, and implemented guidelines for fieldwork. The Bureau, however, lost two staff, (Mr. Stephen Engole Senior Statistician Prices, and Mr. Sam Kaisiromwe, Principal Statistician/Head of the Prices Division), both from the Directorate of Marco Economic Statistics to COVID-19 virus. Also arising from the COVID-19 pandemic, several Bureau activities and some of them include:

Data collection for the Uganda National Household Survey 2019/20 was only completed in November 2020 as opposed to May 2020;

implementation of the Agricultural Integrated surveys planned for May 2020 were differed to May 2021;

The conduct of the National Livestock Census planned for May 2020 was differed to Q4 FY20201;

The Informal Cross Border Trade and data capture of Arrival and Departure Cards at Border statistics were halted and only resumed in March 2021;

The pilot National Service Delivery Survey and the Uganda Demographic and Health survey were postponed to Fy2021;

Census Mapping in preparation for the National Population and Housing Censuses were postponed to Q4 FY2020/21

Despite this, Bureau provided indicators to inform government policy on distribution of food items, masks etc. during the COVID-19 lock-down. The Bureau also, provided key outcome indicators required for measuring the performance of the economy in line with the Mandate of Statistical Production and Coordination of the National Statistics System.

The total approved budget of the Bureau from Government of Uganda (GoU) for FY2020/21 was UGX 60.7Bn; UGX 40.29 as Re-current budget and UGX 20.41 for Retooling. As of March 2021, the funds released to the Bureau amounted to UGX 36.99Bn, of which 51.7% of the approved budget (UGX60.7Bn), was recurrent expenditure and UGX8.65Bn for the Retooling component. The absorption rate for the Bureau on GoU is 76%.
