Matters to note in budget execution during the reporting period, the hospital had challenges with staffs who were transferred without replacement, namely the accountant, internal auditor, stores and procurement officer. The COVID19 restrictions greatly affected service utilization, procurement and attainment of planned activities. The contractor for the staff hostel had to scale down construction due to the COVID19 SOPS and lost man hours due to rain. Lack of a substantive internal auditor greatly affected the audit function of the hospital. Delayed posting of a substantive procurement officer hindered the procurement of medical equipment spare parts for the maintainace workshop, and implementation of the retooling project.

Performance highlights for the Quarter

Jinja RRH has an approved budget of 12.402Bn for FY 2020/2021, of this budget 7.198 is wage, 3.604Bn non-wage recurrent, and capital development of 1.6Bn.

By end of March 2021, the hospital had had received 10.715Bn including domestic arrears as release. Wage release was 5.984Bn, non-wage recurrent 3.387Bn, domestic arrears of 0.084Bn and 1.260Bn as capital Development.

The hospital had utilised 7.363Bn, wage spent was 4.427Bn, Non-wage recurrent 2.433Bn, capital 0.427Bn while arrears were 0.077Bn. Hospital services, the following out puts were achieved during January – March 2021.

- Inpatient services: 7,491 patients were admitted against a target of 8,000 admissions, 920 major operations including caesarean sections (570 major, and 350 caesarean sections). Bed occupancy rate was 73% against the target of 85% while average length of stay stood at 3.5 against a target of 4 days. The hospital registered 1,180 Deliveries (830 normal deliveries and 350 caesarean sections.
- Out Patient services: The hospital registered 46,704 general OPD contacts against a target of 47,000 Quarterly target, specialized services achieved 30,119 patient contacts.
- Medicines: The hospital received and dispensed EMHS worth UGX 226.8M from NMS by end of Q3. While EMHS worth 47.4 Million were procured for private patients.
- Diagnostic Services: During the reporting period, the hospital achieved 1,000 x-ray examinations and 30,000 laboratory tests against a target of 1,250 and 60,000 respectively.
- Preventive services: The hospital provided preventive services to 2,247 mothers who attended ANC, 4,828 Clients were immunized while 318 mothers received Family planning services. This was against a target of 2,750, for ANC, 3,500 immunization target and 1,250 targets for family planning services. Internal audit function: Due to non-availability of the internal auditor, the hospital only achievement was a risk assessment register.
- Regional Maintenance workshop: The hospital technicians carried out Preventive maintenance of the medical equipment within the hospital the region. A Trainer of Trainers for 11 hospital staff on medical equipment was done.
- Capital Development: The hospital had planned to undertake construction of sixteen four storey staff hostel. The scope of works include: 1. Construction of a four storey 16 unit staff house 2. Land scaping, access road, parking and driveway 3. Construction of boundary wall and gate 4. Construction of Storm water drainage. By 31st March 2021, the project progress was at 68 % completion against a target of 85%.
- Under retooling: The hospital had planned to procure assorted Medical equipment worth 210Million. By end of Quarter the procurement process was at Market survey done, contract awarded awaiting delivery of the equipment.
- COVID 19 Response: From March 2020 to end of March 2021 the hospital had received cumulatively 324 confirmed Covid19 cases. Two hundred and seventy five (275) discharges, 38 deaths and 5 referrals out to Mulago. Cummulatively, 79 covid19 suspects had been admitted and screened for COVID19.
