By 31st March 2021, shs6.153 Bn of GOU funding had been released representing 68.6% of the approved budget. Out of the total releases shs 4.278 Bn had been spent representing 47.7% absorption rate. Low absorption rate was noted on Development due to delays in making an advert.
