Matters to note in budget execution

The following are the major reasons for variations in the achievement of the plans:

The process of developing Cost recovery regulations on provision of aeronautical services was hindered by the COVID 19 pandemic due to restriction of movement to COVID prone countries like South Africa where the benchmarking was meant to be carried out.

There were delays in commencement of construction of the Radar Operation Centers because of insufficient funds received hence delaying the process till when more funds were received in the fourth quarter for construction to start.

The Revival of Weather Observations at Airfields of Kisoro, Kihihi, Mbarara, Pakuba, Kidepo not undertaken due to insufficient funds received to procure Aviation Weather Observations Stations.

52 Barometers, 208 Air Thermometers, 52 Anemometers, 52 Sunshine recorders, 300 Rain gauges, 52 Evaporation pans, 208 Soil thermometers not calibrated due to insufficient receipt of funds

Coverage of rainfall stations not increased by 150 Stations since the delivery of the 100 rain gauges was made in the last month of the quarter hence installation could not be undertaken during the financial year

Entebbe International Airport Meteorological Station and upper air station not renovated due to insufficient funds received in the financial year. There was closure of the airport for passenger flights during the COVID 19 period which reduced the demand for flight folders and aviation forecasts.

Performance highlights for the Quarter
