#### Matters to note in budget execution

During the FY 2021/22 Parliament approved a total budget of shs 15.807bn. comprising of shs 1.569 Bn for wage, shs 8.139 Bn for Non-wage and shs 6.100 Bn for development. By 30th September2021, shs 4.369 Bn of GOU funding had been released representing 27.4% of the approved budget. Out of the total releases shs 1.782Bn had been spent representing 42.1% absorption rate. The low absorption rate was attributed to delays ir the procurement process for both the Infrastructural Development Project and Retooling projects and delays in file clearance by Ministry of Public Service for payments of gratuity.
