FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

As at the end of the third Quarter, Vote 161: Mulago Hospital Complex had received UGX 56.87 Bn (82.0%) out of the approved Budget UGX 69.316Bn for FY 2021/22.

Of the approved Ugx 29.581Bn for Wage component of, Ugx 25.048Bn (84.7%) released and Ugx 23.569Bn spent by close of Quarter 3, signaling Wage shortfall for the last Quarter.

Of the approved 31.764Bn for Non-Wage (recurrent), Ugx 23.853Bn released and 22.700Bn absorbed "whereas" Devt. (GoU) was released at 100% (Ugx. 7.97Bn) of which Ugx 4.721Bn (59.2%) spent.
