## V1: VOTE OVERVIEW

### i) Vote Strategic Objectives

As stipulated in Section 21 of the Anti-Money Laundering Act (Cap 118), the objective of the Authority is to:

- Enhance the identification of the proceeds of crime and the combating of money laundering;
- Ensure compliance with the Anti-Money Laundering Act;
- Enhance public awareness and understanding of matters related to money laundering;
- Make information collected by it available to competent authorities and to facilitate the administration and enforcement of the laws of Uganda; and
- Exchange, spontaneously or up on request, any information with similar bodies of other countries that may be relevant for the processing or analysis of information relating to money laundering or terrorism financing.
