I. VOTE MISSION STATEMENT

To foster the integrity of the financial system through effective detection and prevention of financial crimes.

II. STRATEGIC OBJECTIVE

As stipulated in Section 21 of the Anti-Money Laundering Act (Cap 118), the objective of the Authority is to:

- a) Enhance the identification of the proceeds of crime and the combating of money laundering;
- b) Ensure compliance with the Anti-Money Laundering Act;
- c) Enhance public awareness and understanding of matters related to money laundering;
- d) Make information collected by it available to competent authorities and to facilitate the administration and enforcement of the laws of Uganda; and
- e) Exchange, spontaneously or up on request, any information with similar bodies of other countries that may be relevant for the processing or analysis of information relating to money laundering or terrorism financing.

III. MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2025/26

Resulting from the implementation of the FY 2025/26 approved workplan and budget as aligned to the NDP IV Governance and Security Program Implementation Action Plan, the following key achievements were registered by the Authority as of half-year (July 2025 - December 2025):

- a) Concluded 03 ML/TF Risk Assessments on Virtual Assets (VAs) and Virtual Assets Service Providers (VASPs), Designated Non-Financial Businesses and Professions (DNFBPs) and Trafficking in Persons and smuggling of migrants.
- b) Undertook 09 Risk based onsite inspections on targeted Accountable Persons to ascertain adequacy of internal controls, identify potential risks and vulnerabilities, and inform corrective action.
- c) 91 Accountable Persons were trained and onboarded on goAML, bringing the total cumulative number of registrations to 1,869 entities and 21,573 reports received through the goAML system during the period under review.
- d) Generated and disseminated 64 intelligence information reports to Law Enforcement Agencies and Competent Authorities for further management. The 64 intelligence reports comprised 15 proactive and 49 reactive intelligence reports.
- e) Responded to 47 requests for information from different LEAs and Competent Authorities. 18 Incoming and 05 Outgoing international Requests for Information were received and sent out respectively from and to other FIUs. Additionally, 05 Incoming and 03 Outgoing Spontaneous Disclosures were handled, demonstrating effective international cooperation in the fight against financial crime.
- f) Finalised 05 of the 06 FDD requests received (worth over UGX 4.09 trillion) and disseminated the reports to the requesting MDAs to facilitate credible investment decision making for Government of Uganda.
- g) Enhanced capacity of 2,627 participants (1,380 male and 1,247 females) from various accountable persons, supervisory bodies and law enforcement agencies on ML/TF/PF crimes, and their associated obligations.
- h) Coordinated the Regulatory Impact Assessment for the amendment of the Anti-Money Laundering Act Cap 118, and the Second National AML/CFT

Strategy for Uganda, for the 2025/26-2029/30 period.

i) 1 guidance note on Politically Exposed Persons (PEPs) was developed and disseminated to assist Accountable Persons in meeting their statutory obligations by providing practical, risk-based direction for identifying, assessing, and applying appropriate controls when establishing or maintaining business relationships with PEPs.

j) Maintained membership in ESAAMLG and EGMONT, and 100% representation of Uganda at pertinent technical engagements.

k) Coordinated the preparation and submission of Uganda's 7th request for re-rating report on 4 FATF Recommendations namely 7, 28, 33 and 40, for consideration at the March/April 2026 ESAAMLG Meeting. By the end Q2 FY 25/26, Uganda was rated Compliant on 29 of the 40 FATF recommendations.

l) Maintained an up-to-date database of National AML/CFT/CPF value-chain statistics.

m) Published 12 informative articles, engaged 50 participants/members of the press and targeted leaders in Greater Masaka region, sensitized 4,182 members of the public, and leveraged social/digital platforms and electronic media (radio talk shows) to advance the AML/CFT/CPF awareness agenda.

VI. VOTE NARRATIVE

Vote Challenges

The major challenges encountered by FIA in execution of its mandate include:

- a) Gaps in the AML/CFT/CPF legal and regulatory framework, limiting the sufficient execution of required regulatory and supervisory interventions.
- b) Lack of prioritization of AML/CFT/CPF strategic actions by stakeholders in the AML/CFT/CPF value chain ranging from prevention, detection, investigation, prosecution, deterrence, and confiscation.
- c) Limited AML/CFT/CPF knowledge and skills of Law Enforcement Agencies and Competent Authorities to investigate ML/TF/PF crimes given the complexities, and ever-evolving trends of financial crime.
- d) Funding variations (annual appropriations vis-a-vis Strategic Plan requirement) creating deficiencies in certain areas such as;
 - i) ICT systems and operational assets.
 - ii) technical capacity amongst staff.
 - iii) training of accountable persons, particularly DNFPs.
 - iv) Limited public awareness on matters related to AML/CFT as provided for in AMLA.
 - v) onsite inspections which negatively impacts on effective enforcement of compliance with AMLA.
 - vi) supervision of ML/TF/PF to the unregulated sectors like the real estate dealers in precious stones and gems, Virtual Assets Service Providers among others that are attractive to launderers.

Plans to improve Vote Performance

The Authority strives to become a centre of excellence in combating money laundering, terrorism financing and proliferation financing. As such, in line with the NDP IV Strategic Intervention to Strengthen Anti-Money Laundering Mechanisms, the FIA strategic goal is An Effective framework to combat financial crime, protect the integrity of Uganda's financial system, and ensure safety and security of the broader economy.

In order to facilitate realization of the set aspirations, in light of the existing challenges and need for continuous improvement, the Authority will focus on:

- a) Fast-tracking of Legal and Regulatory amendments as guided by the already finalized Regulatory Impact Assessment in order to close all existing gaps.
- b) Execution of targeted high-level stakeholder engagements (for stakeholders with AML/CFT/CPF strategic actions) to prioritize recommended actions as guided by the National AML/CTF/CPF Strategy for Uganda.
- c) Leveraging ICT for continuous automations and integrations to permit effective and efficient operations.
- d) Prioritization of targeted training and capacity enhancement engagements for Law Enforcement Agencies, Competent Authorities and Accountable Persons as guided by the National AML/CTF/CPF Strategy for Uganda, and FIA Training and Outreach Strategy.
