### Vote Challenges

1. Budget Cut of UGX. 9.49bn from UGX. 11.160bn in FY 2022/23 to UGX. 1.67bn in FY 2023/24. This budget cut is going to affect fulfilment of contractual obligations under the Central Teaching Facility Construction.
2. Non allocation of a Project Code to the Successor Project of Project 0906 despite fulfilment of all the Development Committee requirements. This implies that allocation of funds to the rollover contractual obligations cannot be made.
3. Release of funds on a quarterly basis rather than on a semester basis as was before.

### Plans to improve Vote Performance

The University will focus on investment in ICT infrastructure to support eLearning in order to increase revenue as a result of increase in enrolment without an increase in lecture space.

Operationalization of the Directorate of Quality Assurance to ensure quality service delivery

Establish a department of electronic and Life long learning.
