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Quarter 1

Performance highlights for the Quarter

The Commission disposed off 26 cases out of which all the 26 were closed. The Disciplinary committee had 9 sittings where it handled 70 Complaints and recommended closure of 47 complaints due to lack of merit in the complaints, death of the judicial officers, retirement from judicial service, and/or withdrawal of the complaint by the complainant, 4 for Interface, 4 for Further Investigations, 2 Ongoing hearings, 6 Adjourned for further consideration, 2 Letters to responsible officers, and 5 complaint for plea taking and charging. 18 complaints against Judicial officers and non-Judicial Officers were fully investigated.

The Commission rendered advice to the Appointing Authority for the Appointment of the of Chairperson and Vice Chairperson of Electricity Disputes Tribunal; and Registrar for the Insurance Appeals Tribunal. The Commission also conducted interviews for the positions of Justice Court of Appeal, High Court Judge and Competence test for 271 candidates for the post of Magistrates Grade One.

The Commission undertook Court Compliance Checks in 04 Magisterial Areas of Oyam Magisterial area, Anaka Magisterial Area, Kapchorwa Magisterial area and Sironko Magisterial area. The Commission also held one (1) Mobile complaints handling & investigations in the district of Arua where a total of 1,290 clients were attended too, of which 104 clients at the venue and 1,186 in prison).

The Commission conducted 2 live Radio Talks shows on anti-corruption initiatives and 2 live Radio Talk shows on land justice, money lending, court system and Trial procedure, bail and police bond, children's rights, domestic violence and marriage laws. In addition, the commission conducted 1 Anti-corruption workshop; Engagement with 2 Local Council Courts on functionality and roles on procedure, land cases, handling cases of Children and cases of domestic violence in Eastern Uganda district of Busia; 2 engagements with court users and 5 School sensitizations.

Variances and Challenges

The Commission still faces transport challenges that affects timely activity implementation. The Commission's fleet is also past the recommended mileage and age which makes it expensive to maintain.

The Commission also faces challenge of office equipment. There has been low release of funds under retooling project over the years which has limited the Commission to retool and provide appropriate office equipment to it's staff.

The Commission had a staffing gap majorly under the critical departments. This over works the lean staff and therefore affect delivery.

The Commission is not yet fully automated which affects its service delivery to the public. There is a need to fully automate all the business processes for the commission to increase efficiency and effectiveness.
