### Performance highlights for the Quarter

- 1. In an effort to further boost poultry breeding and production, two hatchery machines with a capacity of 120,600 hatchable eggs per week have been installed and are now functional at Wakiso Poultry Development Centre. The Agency now has a stocking capacity of 70,000 stocks per cycle and hatching capacity of 250,000 eggs per cycle on the government farms and ranches hosting the poultry enterprise
- 2. To continuously address the animal feed scarcity on government farms and among the farming communities countrywide during the quarter, the agency was able to process a total of 326.85MT of compounded livestock feeds at Kasolwe feed mill, Kamuli

### Variances and Challenges

- 1. Erratic budget releases have continued to hinder the implementation of key planned activities especially the ones that directly contribute to the successful implementation of the Parish Development Model. For instance, UGX25.8bn of the total approved budget was not released and this made it difficult for the agency to restock the deserving government ranches and farms, establish the much-needed livestock breeding and production support infrastructure among others
- 2. The presence of violent encroachers on Government farms and ranches is still a big challenge and this has consistently watered livestock breeding and production efforts
