#### Variances and Challenges

- 1. National Council for Higher Education faced logistical challenges. National Council for Higher Education has 5 field vehicles, 2 of the vehicles are beyond the 5 years and due for disposal. This leaves NCHE with 3 vehicles to oversee 258 higher institutions of learning located through out the country.
- 2. There was no provision for funding for the National Council for Higher Education Infrastructural Development (Main Building). The inadequate funding negatively impact on the implementation of planned activities.
- 3. Limitation of the current Universities and Other Tertiary Institutions (UOTI) Act, Cap.262 which cannot allow full and quick implementation of NCHE mandate.
